Learn how to draw a beautifully realistic portrait from a photo using classical techniques.

The instructor will demonstrate how to use the time-honored method of sight-size drawing to create stunningly realistic portrait results without using gridding.

Students will learn the anatomy of facial features as well as how to utilize graphite to obtain a beautiful finish to believable form. Students will work at their own pace encouraged by personalized critiques. Prior to class, students will be given a handout providing instruction as to the methods of posing and lighting the subject for a beautiful portrait. Students will arrive with a great photo reference ready for the first day of class!
