### ABOUT The Sculpture Project

We are creating a series of **life-size bronze statues of notable citizens** who made unique and extraordinary contributions to our community. They will be permanent installations throughout Manchester. The first statue is of **Joe McCluskey**, 1911- 2002. Still considered to be Manchester's greatest athlete, Joe was an **Olympic medalist, national recordholder**, and **four-time Manchester Road Race winner**. His statue will be located along the Road Race route across from Highland Park Market, on the East Coast Greenway walking trail.
