But if we think of this war as a struggle of the years ago per day there is something better to do than to allow the Japs to keep our feet a prisoner in the Pacific. That something is to let them know that we are not going to let them beat waters and put the Japanese navy where it will no longer be a menace on the bottom of the sea. Then without the waste of a day or an hour, head our own ships straight for the Panama Canal and bring them into the Atlantic. It would eliminate the "two-ocean war."

Such a course would probably cut long years off the duration of the job of insuring our own safety for all time and of ridding the world of the Hitler-Mussolini cancer. Any such proposal would undoubtedly horrify every isolationist and pacifist in the country almost to a fainting fit. But nothing could be surer, any longer, that the isolationist and pacifist fight. We shall not surrender—and if we must fight, in the name of all that is sane let it be the fight of a world, not a nation.
