The Red Army is reported to have captured the railroads in the area of the Polish town of Lublitz, 17 miles northwest of Danzig. Premier Marshal Stalin announced today that his government is prepared to discuss the midweek curfew for entertainment places today was formally assigned to the War Manpower Commission.

Britain Wants Greater Role In Jap War

enabled Roosevelt and Churchill to hold "new and important" discussions on the Pacific. These were possible during their meeting in Britain at Yalta because where Japan is concerned Russia is still neutral.

"Mr. Churchill told the President in blunt words," the report said, "that his government was determined to throw every interest and resource into the war against Germany."

This is the same sort of promise of British intentions which has been given several times in the past and particularly after the Quebec conference late last summer.

Many military authorities here believe that Churchill's repeated emphasis on the point is to keep Britain's part in the Japanese war in the forefront of American thinking with a view to obtaining a greater role for her in the Pacific and a greater voice in both strategic and political decisions.

The direct attack of the British empire in Asia is enormous but the planning and direction of the Pacific war up to this time have been almost entirely American.

The future of Britain's assignment is understood to be, unless changed, primarily campaign operations in the Southeast Asia and Indian sectors whereas the British have been reported as wanting Japan and Japanese-held China.

But whatever his friendly discussions with the prime minister, Mr. Roosevelt came against an entirely different situation in his efforts to get together with General de Gaulle.

The president was "most disappointed" the official report said, by he had wanted to take up questions of "mutual interest and importance" to France and the United States.

That the French have sought more detail on the terms would be disclosed at the state department.
