## Army Hopes To Save Most of Equipment

### 70 Per Cent Planning Objective Subject to Change; Remainder to Be Fritted Off

Washington, April 6.—The Army hopes to bring out of Europe 70 per cent of the equipment left over after the defeat of Germany. The other 30 per cent—or more—either will be written off as not worth saving or as material retained in setting the 70 per cent salvage program.

Officials explain it is simply a planning objective to check up on the amount of equipment in the war. It does furnish the starting point for estimating how much more will be kept in mind, according to military leaders.

**Will Get New Weapons**

The first combat troops in Europe will be supplied with new arms and equipment from the United States, that is the intention, they say. It is the latest word to get them into the new war.

Not until many months after the war ends will the munitions from Europe pile up in the western Pacific, and when they do, the supply of new armament from the United States.
