State Capitol, Hartford, May 15.—(P)—The Senate, concurring with the House, unanimously approved today a bill giving the governor emergency powers to deal with food shortages in the state. The measure, sent by the House yesterday, would permit the governor to seize all food in transit, in warehouses or processing plants and in any other place where food is being stored or prepared for distribution.
