line—against the hard fighting between the Japanese and the Americans.

This thrust cut off some Japanese units from the heights. It extended an envelopment around a considerable distance south of Yushan.

Vern Houghland, Associated Press front-page correspondent, said one of the 96th had a tough scrap while moving down heights on the approaches to Yushan but the actual entry virtually was unopposed.

Actual Curtail Operations

In the center and on the west, Marine and infantry operations were curtailed by heavy rains. On the west side of the line, the Japanese threw one of their frequent counter-attacks before dawn Sunday but the First Marine Division of Maj. Gen. Fred A. Del Valle crushed it, killing 800 of the enemy.

Maj. Gen. Lemuel G. Shepherd, Jr., 5th Marine Division, said the division's positions along the Asato river in the northern edge of the island were unopposed.

At dusk Monday, 12 of more enemy planes attempted to raid the island. The Japanese reported that they shot down one of the planes and destroyed the other four. These Reports Are Based On Prior Notification To Next of Kin and Casualties Noted Here May Previously Have Been Reported in the News Columns.

Army Casualties and Liberated War Prisoners for May 22, 1945.

The War Department casualty list, Serial Numbers 0-332 (MIA), Pacific, 49, 0-333 (missing, Pacific, 44), 0-334 (wounded, Europe, 194), and 0-337 (killed, Europe, 271), announced for the United States as follows: 1,398 casualties for May 22, 1945, classified as follows: 560 killed, 178 wounded, and 660 missing.

The War Department also announced, on Serial No. 0-338, for the United States as follows: 485 Army personnel freed from German prison camps.

The Navy Department announced for the United States as a whole 422 casualties for May 22, 1945, of the U. S. These casualties being the total reported to next of kin and released for publication on December 7, 1941, to May 22, 1945, to 1945, classified as follows:

held the office since May 10, 1940, when he succeeded Neville Chamberlain during some of the darkest days of the war.

Churchill's resignation was precipitated by the Labor party's refusal to continue in the coalition government, now that Germany is defeated.

Lampsons Prime Minister. An old-fashioned political campaign already was under way, with the opposition press lampooning the prime minister.

Churchill's resignation was presented to King George VI at Buckingham Palace.
