Hadden Named As Legal Head

Becomes Connecticut Attorney General When Pallotti Resigns.

Hartford, June 14 (AP)—William L. Hadden, former lieutenant governor and one-time New Haven newspaperman, has been named to succeed Francis A. Pallotti as attorney general of Connecticut.

Gov. Raymond E. Baldwin announced Hadden's appointment yesterday simultaneously with his resignation.

Hadden, 44, was born in New Haven, Conn., and graduated from the University of Michigan Law School in 1914. He was admitted to the Connecticut bar in 1918, when he was appointed assistant clerk of the West Haven town court.

Hadden served this tribunal as a prosecutor from 1925 to 1927 in which year he was named judge, a post he held until 1937. He also served as West Haven town counsel and chairman of the zoning appeals board.

After two terms in the Connecticut House of Representatives, serving as majority leader in the running race and defeated Oddie Shepard, Democrat, for lieutenant governor.

More recently, Baldwin named him a special assistant attorney general in court action to deter-

mine whether John T. McCarthy of Shelton, Democratic holdover, or Elinor S. Watson of Waterbury, Democrat, of the south Pacific, is state motor vehicles commissioner.
