United Aircraft Will Not Resume Production Until Sept. 4

Hartford, Aug. 24.—(AP)—Production at the giant Pratt & Whitney and the Hamilton Standard Propellers division of the United Aircraft Corporation here and at the Chance Vought division at Stratford, originally scheduled for resumption on Aug. 27, has been deferred until Sept. 4 by Corporation President H. M. Hornet. Hornet said in a statement today that the situation would not be clarified until all the corporation's new schedules were authorized by the War Relocation Authority of approximately 20,000 at Pratt & Whitney and the Hamilton Standard Propellers and of roughly 8,000 at the Chance Vought division and at the Sikorsky Aircraft division at Bridgeport.

To Resume Limited Operations

The Sikorsky division will resume limited factory operations on the original Aug. 27 date, Hornet said.

The president also announced that factory operations would not be resumed in the satellite plants of the Hamilton division at Norwich and Westbury, R. I. He said that satellite plants of Pratt & Whitney Aircraft at Hartford, Middletown, Southington, Williamston and East Longmeadow, Mass., would probably be closed in the near future with all operations concentrated in the main plants here.

Bill Taking Inventories

Hornet said that the taking of termination inventories in cooperation with Army and Navy cancellations could not be completed before Sept. 4. He added that "drastically reduced schedules now in progress" for the three divisions would permit partial operations in some departments of the divisions for at least the next several months.

"The government," he said, "has announced its intention of continuing experimental and development contracts, and we will maintain our research and development staff to assure America's supremacy in the air in the future."

In all divisions, new designs are approaching the production stage. As development work in these new models is completed, it is now expected that manufacturing operations will be resumed on a basis more or less comparable to that existing prior to the cessation.

"Our future employment will, of course, depend heavily upon national air policy."

These boys had luck. They beat priority. In general, they are men destined for discharge. Separated from their old organizations and moving as individuals they did not have the priority of travel set originally when redeployment of manpower to the Pacific was urgent. Under normal circumstances they might have been among the last to leave Europe by ocean ships, months hence.

The Army Air Forces' Air Transport command, however, had planes—hundreds of them—ready for use. The world's greatest airline was set up, the "Green Project" for flying soldiers home.

This is an instance of where the short way home is the long way around—3,000 miles by ship, more than twice the distance by the air route down from Casablanca, across the Equator and the Atlantic to Natal and up through the Caribbean to the United States. But troop ships average ten or 12 days on the North Atlantic run. Soldiers making the trip over the southern legs of the Green Project reach the United States in about three days.

Transfer Point

Panama City Field and its huge military encampment is the transfer point for the soldier-traveler. He lands here at the halfway mark home in a C-54, four-engine transport; perhaps a little weary of hearing the roar of airplane engines for 17 hours and a little more fed up with K rations—but with the way. The big plane lands up to the line, American Army representatives climb aboard, including heavy bags who give a spot health check. Last any medical hitch-hiker heavy bags have some along, a heavy dose of insecticide spray fills the ship.

Kog's Hill Here Was Site Of Indian Gathering Place

Kog's Hill, which lies west of Middle Turnpike East and at the extremity of Indian Drive, Manchester Green, is one of the most noted gathering places of the Indians found in this town. According to Matthias Spies, well known authority on the early natives of Connecticut, Kog's Hill was a great assembly place for Indians gathering nuts in the fall of the year.

In proof of this, Spies has found 33 campsites of Indians around the hill, indicating that at times during the fall as many as 150 Indian squaws and children lived on the hill during the nutting season.

Spies states that he has found what is perhaps the largest campsite in the state. According to the information received it must have been the scene of a tribal council meeting place. These campsites are very well defined and are so realistic that it seems as if the Indians who left them must be roaming about in the vicinity.

Japanese New Yale Course

Army Enlisted Men to Be Given Six Months' Teaching at University

New Haven, Aug. 24.—(AP)—Col. William F. Howe, commandant of the Army training schools at Yale university, has announced the start of a six-month course in Japanese for enlisted men.

Enrollment in the new school is expected to reach a high of 1,200 by next April, the colonel stated Thursday. Seventy-seven men already are enrolled, he said, with the remainder scheduled to enroll as follows: Nov. 5, 45; Jan. 7, 1946, 150; Feb. 4, 220; and April 2, 270.

The course, Colonel Howe said, will include instruction in the social, economic and political structure of Japan, and of the Japanese language. It is similar to that shorter than by six months a course in Far Eastern studies which has been conducted at Yale for enlisted men for the past year.

To Be Taught on Old Campus

All of the incoming trainees will be housed on the old campus, Colonel Howe said in Wright, Parham Hall. Duffie hall, now used as a post exchange and storehouse, will be turned into a classroom.

Colonel Howe also announced the discontinuance of the special school to teach Chinese to Army officers and enlisted men on New Haven, which has been in existence at Yale since January, 1943.

There are four classes totaling 123 trainees in this program at present, the colonel said, and by Nov. 30, 190 officers and 270 enlisted men will have been graduated.

The only other Army unit remaining on the campus, Colonel Howe said, is a detachment of 71 second, third, and fourth year medical students.
