The Doctor Says:

Flu Signs Sometimes Mean Bruellosis

By William A. O'Brien, M.D.
Writes for NEA Service

A young basketball player reported to the team physician for an examination in mid-season. The coach had used him in every game, but lately the player hadn't felt quite well. He had a little fever at times. A specimen of blood sent to the public health laboratories, was sent to the doctor. The doctor found that the player had been drinking raw milk which came from infected cows.

It is the almost unanimous opinion of the scientists who worked on it or related projects that the "bomb" was a good secret so long as it was a complete secret.

When the first bomb was dropped on Hiroshima and was announced at Washington, the secret was not kept. This was and is important for two reasons, even had Washington never spoken another word on the subject:

1. It proved that an atomic bomb could be made. That was an incentive to scientists elsewhere to work on it.
2. It proved that an atomic bomb was even more destructive than the first one. It therefore became imperative for other powers to work on it.

But the United States government, having spent \$2,000,000,000 on the project, did not stop with announcing the fact of the bomb. The government had a long and comprehensive report on its development.

Tells Lot To Scientists
Competent physicists say this tells a lot of what an outside world must know to make a bomb.

President Truman dumped the whole problem of domestic control in the lap of Congress and said he was talking with the British and Canadians about international control. Later he said he would not divulge industrial secrets of the bomb's manufacture.

Those same competent physicists say that will not keep the Russians or any other great nation from making atomic bombs in three to five years.

Now middle points on the table with the rest of the cards.

No one in Washington thinks seriously that the United States is going to have a war with any country in the world. The critical period will be after the war has recovered from the war just ended. Say 15 to 20 years.

Among Most Serious Problems
This on the best scientific evidence it means certain that any nation capable of fighting the bombs by the time it needs them, will be able to do so.

1. How to recognize the land, sea and air forces of the nation to meet the new strategic and tactical threats of the bomb.
2. How to define the nation's "frontiers" for maximum protection—if any—against atomic attack.
3. How to make more and better A-bombs in line with the developing policy of peace through power, as contrasted with the pre-war policy of peace through weakness.
4. How to develop industrial use of atomic energy. This will inevitably result in new discoveries that will contribute greatly to military uses.

But all these are subordinate to the main problem—how to prevent another war too terrible to contemplate.
