### Finds Pastor Negligent In Fitzgerald Death

#### Coroner B. J. Ackerman Holds Norwich Minister at Fault for Bolton Fatality on October 20

In his report filed today Bernard J. Ackerman, coroner for Tolland county, holds Rev. David A. Pitt, 68, of 80 Williams street, Norwich, the "negligent operator of his motor vehicle" on October 20, causing the death of William L. Fitzgerald, of Manchester, in Bolton. The report gives in detail the actions of the minister from the time he was called to the scene of the accident. It also tells of his taking a phrenograph bill before leaving Hartford.

The phrenograph, a 48-year-old, late of 156 Bessell street, Manchester, came to a violent and untimely death on October 21, 1945, as a result of injuries sustained when struck by a 1940 Plymouth sedan, registration NP-128, Conn., owned and operated by Rev. David A. Pitt, age 66, of 80 Williams street, Norwich, Connecticut. The accident occurred on October 20, 1945, about 4:00 p. m. on the main road of New England Telephone Company, near No. 646, Slinger Hill, Bolton. About 2:00 p. m. the 60-foot car struck on October 20, 1945, Rev. Pitt had been in the office of a physician at 50 Farmington Avenue in the city of Hartford, for medical examination and treatment and while waiting for the doctor there, he states he had taken a phrenograph bill for the purpose of controlling his hypertension. The bill, he states, probably contained a sedative and he took them with some regularity by directing his physician to carry them on his person. He further states that he has been deceiving for over seven years and that he has high blood pressure.

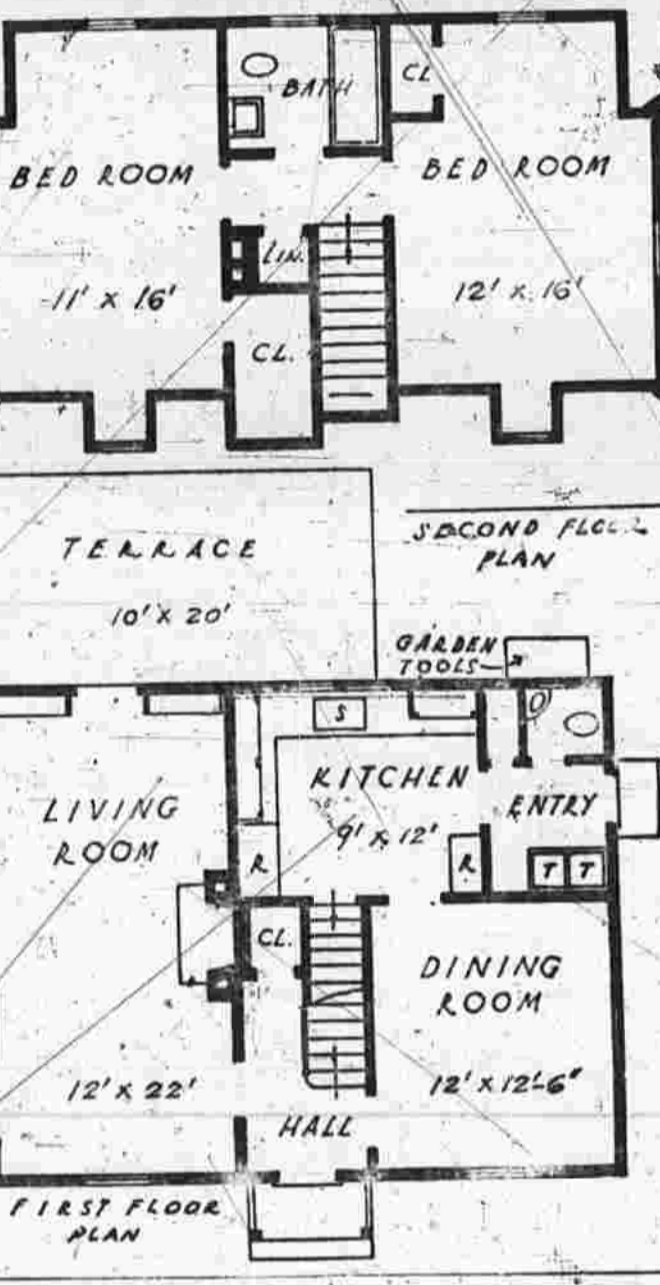

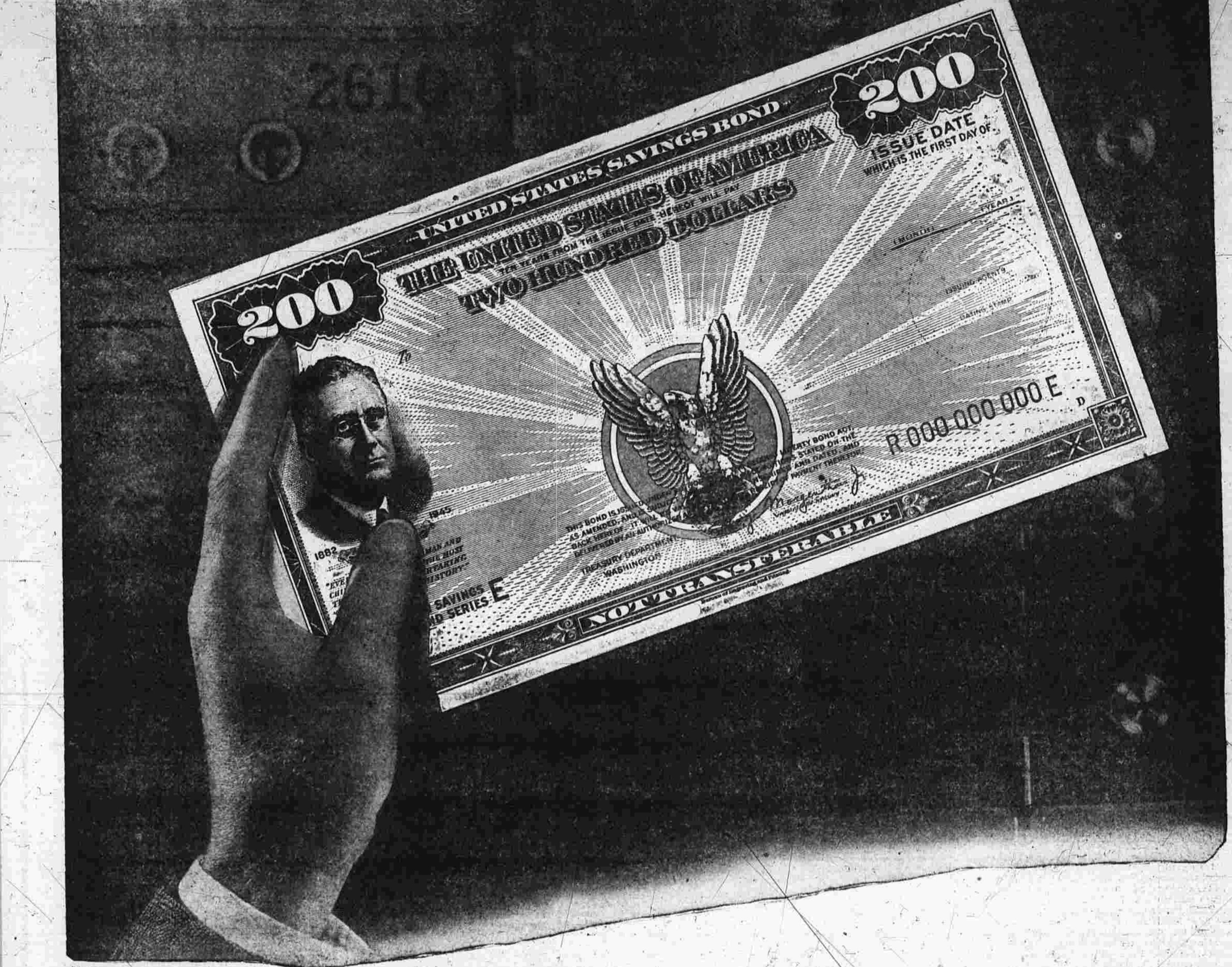


