The joyous tidings, "Peace, good will".

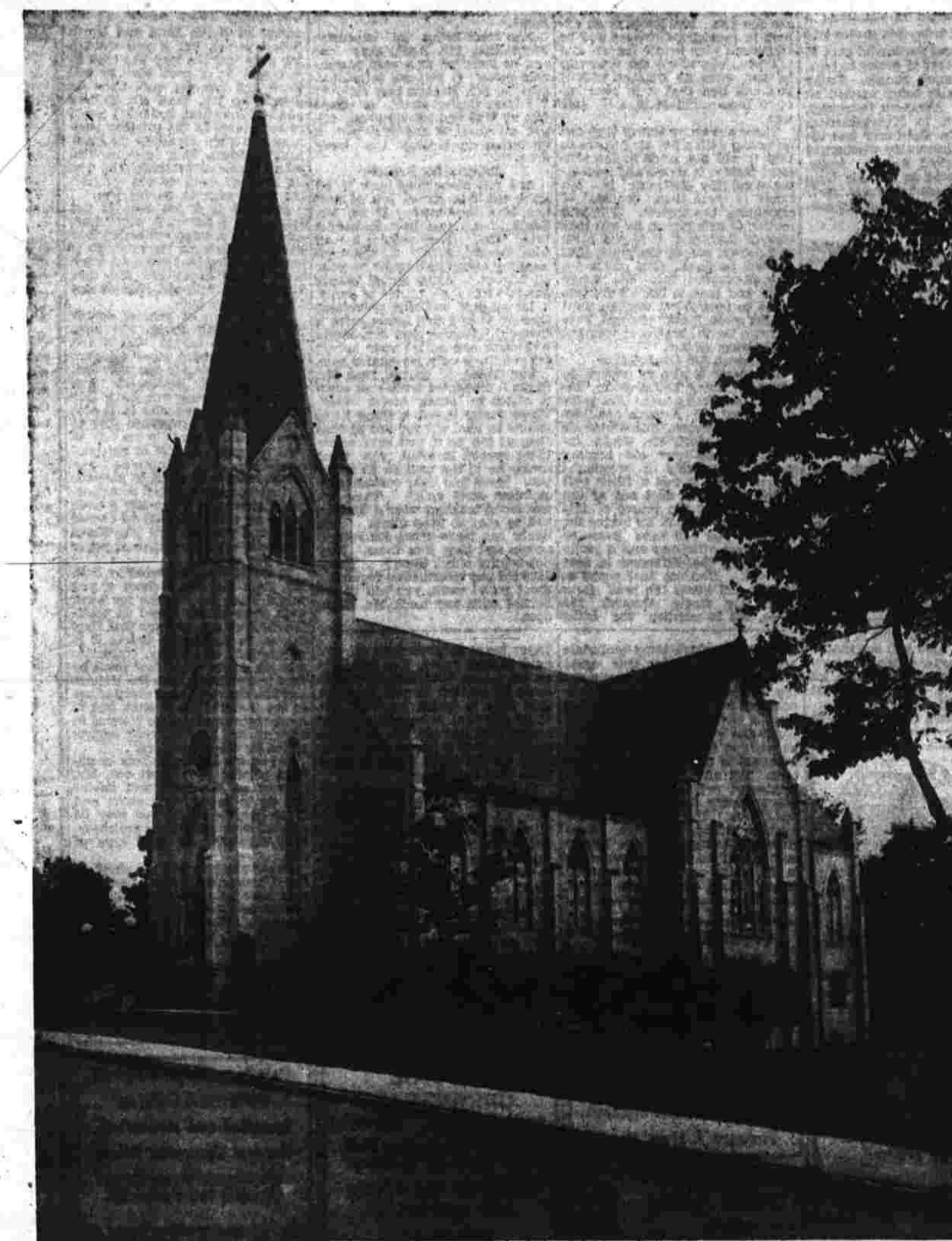
O let us go with quiet mind,

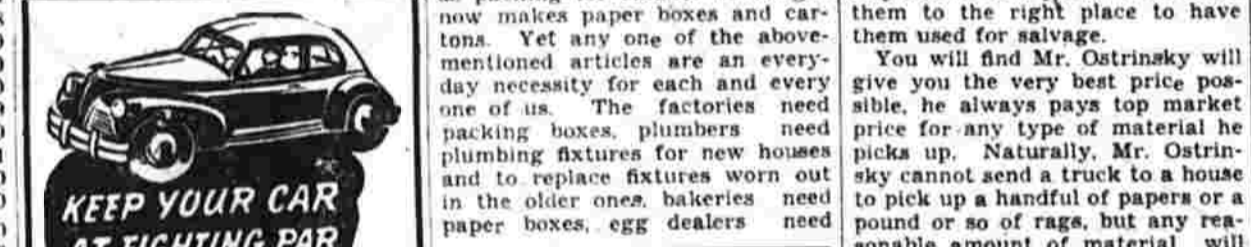
