

Mixed Brew From Samovar
 That temper in a samovar over the meeting of the Anglo-Soviet treaty has ended in a precarious pleasantness as the result of Premier Stalin's kind acceptance of what Foreign Minister Bevin said about the treaty, in contrast with what Pravda, presumably his own newspaper, said.

Stalin pronounces himself and Bevin to be in agreement on the value of the Anglo-Soviet alliance, and also on the British suggestion that it should be extended. Here, however, with a characteristic slip of Russian tongue, he questions the presence of certain "reservations" in the present form of the treaty. Actually, this surface agreement with Bevin is still cloaking a profound sense of dissatisfaction with the treaty, and he is holding this dissatisfaction still over the heads of the British—either still a denunciation or depreciation of the existing treaty, or the negotiation of a new one.

The only "reservations" in the Anglo-Soviet treaty are clauses to the effect that Britain and Russia are undertaking their pledge of mutual assistance "pending the adoption of proposals for common action by the great powers by all nations, and that if Britain and Russia should ever become satisfied that such proposals for common action on the part of all nations provided sufficient guarantee of security, then they could agree that their special treaty had been superseded by such collective security.

This treaty was drawn before the creation of the United Nations and these "reservations" actually anticipated the creation of something like the United Nations. Now that the United Nations has been organized Britain and Russia have the privilege, if they will, of regarding the United Nations as sufficient guarantee of their own security and of abandoning their own special alliance in favor of that collective brand of security.

When Stalin, then, talks about these "reservations" as important in the Anglo-Soviet treaty, he is talking as if he accepts the United Nations as no guarantee of security whatsoever, and as if he wanted a new alliance which would clearly establish the special mutual defense arrangement between Britain and Russia as more important and reliable than anything the United Nations could offer.

Why this controversy began, then, with a Russian interpretation that Bevin was denouncing the Anglo-Soviet treaty, it has now come to the point where Stalin seems, indirectly at least, to be denouncing the United Nations and rejecting it. And this, instead of being the surface good news it seems to British headlines, is no other news indeed, if it is not just one more temporary contradiction in Russian policy. For, in patching up this long-range quarrel with the British, Stalin seems to be implying a new and fundamental quarrel with the whole concept behind the United Nations. What he shall do with what he has learned from Moscow tomorrow.


