



Death Sentence Given for Spying

Warsaw. Feb. 4—(P)— The death sentence was meted out yesterday by a military tribunal to Marian Golebiowski, former Polish Army officer, while nine co-defendants received two to 10-year prison terms on charges of spying for a foreign power. Col. Jan Rzepecki, accused ring-leader of the movement, was sentenced to eight years after he had "repented" and asked a chance to start life anew.

The 10 men were convicted of The 10 men were convicted acting as agents of Lieut. Gen. Wladyslaw Anders, war-time com-Wladyslaw Anders, war-time commander of free Polish forces, to organize espionage in behalf of a foreign power and armed resistance to the Warsaw regime.

Meanwhile a military tribunal at Krakow sentenced to death seven university students accused of being members of the "League for Fighting Bolshevism" and of cooperating with the NSZ underground movement in looting and diversionist activities. Seven other youths were sentenced to prison




