School Housing Here Now Serious Problem

Immediate Action Necessary Chairman Hears Of Education Board Says; Cites New Needs

The critical school plant conditions facing Manchester today drew from Senator Charles S. House, chairman of the Board of Education, the observation that the special town meeting Monday night is of the utmost importance to every parent in the town, as at that session may be settled the question of adequate educational facilities here for several years to come.

Citing the "serious condition" which is fast becoming more acute, the Herald explains the problem of overcrowding in the school buildings, and the primary requirement for a complete and competent survey of the town's entire present and future educational needs.

The entire situation is summed up by Senator House in his letter, which follows:

"Editor The Herald: In view of the particular importance of Monday night's town meeting to the future of the town, I would appreciate the privilege of your columns in order to engage engineers and architects to prepare plans and specifications of new school buildings."

"Certain background information is important to consideration of both of these items."

Deficit in Housing

"At the present time, at the maximum recommended capacity of 23 pupils per room, we have a seating capacity in our schools of 4,200. Our present enrollment is 4,745, leaving a deficit seating capacity at the maximum recommendation of 465."

"The report of the Town Planning Study made by Professor Adams and his associates from I. T. in 1945 shows an anticipated enrollment in the schools by 1955 of 5,830 pupils which would, if no new buildings were constructed, result in a seating capacity deficit of 1,580."
