Salter's Pond About Ready

Finishing touches being put on bathing house; To Open on Monday

Finishing touches are being applied to the bathing house at Salter's Pond and all will be ready for the formal opening of the pool Monday.

Provisions have been made for both men and women at the building by James Sheehey, the town engineer who planned the interior. The section for men and boys is located on the west end of the building. The center section is given over to checking clothing and valuables of the bathers, and where they also may secure a towel. The women and girls dressing room and facilities have been placed in the east end of the Quonset.

Both sides have been provided with toilets, dressing stalls, and shower baths. An open room has been provided in both ends for the younger people to dress. To secure the necessary materials for finishing the interior it was necessary to do much shopping around. Barry last fall Sheehey learned that one of the best places to get a big where materials were to be secured was to check loads being brought into town by trucks by visiting the Acadia diner and talking to the drivers of the trucks. They were carrying, where they were going, and to what company they were being sent. With this information it often meant an early morning start to the destination of the trucks, which were as far away as times as Bridgeport, to arrive before the truck was unloaded and get a share of the scarce material.

Can Park 500 Cars

The grading has been completed around the bathhouse and provisions have been made for the parking of as many as 500 automobiles on the Lyford stage side. Seating has been brought in and a beach has been laid from the Lyford stage to the bathhouse. A new bridge has been built across the dam, and a drinking fountain has been installed on the Lyford stage. The entire grounds have been fenced in with wire link fence. It will be possible for the life guard on duty to view any part of the pond from almost any place along the south shore or from the dam where he is usually stationed.

All this work has been completed for the benefit of the youngsters, but already there have been several complaints of vandalism. Windows have been broken, and damage was made to the building and considerable damage was done to the interior. The gate on the west end has been broken in, evidently by an automobile which was driven against the gate. The police have been notified and at the last meeting of the Police Commission the chief was instructed to have the cruiser patroll the place during the night to protect it from further acts of this kind.
