Communists from the UAW. Stating he "regretted and deplored" the necessity of publicizing the resolution, the secretary-treasurer said recent events had "forced" to take the action.

Town May Establish First Reserve Fund

Call for the Town Meeting; Details of Bowers' Resolution

Manchester may establish the first reserve fund for the town's capital improvements, it was announced at a meeting held last night by the Board of Selectmen on motion of Selectman Sherman D. Bowers.

It was the unanimous opinion of the board that such a fund, built up over the years by annual increments, will fill a great need in the town's financial picture, but opposition to the plan was voiced by some members of the board.

Chairman of the Board Carl H. England stated he felt that the matter was one properly to come before the new Board of Directors at its first meeting in October. He stated that the town's financial picture after the present Selectmen's term expires in October is not clear, and that it would be better to have the question brought up at that time.

The Board of Directors is to meet on October 14 at 8 o'clock at the town hall. The meeting will be held in the morning and will be open to the public.

Bowers' resolution provides that the town shall set aside a reserve fund for capital and non-current expenses. The fund is to be built up by a percentage of the town's annual income, to be determined by the Board of Directors.

The fund is to be used for the purchase of bonds, the purchase of land, and the purchase of buildings. The fund is also to be used for the purchase of equipment and for the payment of interest on town bonds.

The Board of Directors is to report to the town meeting on the progress of the fund and on the amount of the reserve fund.

The Board of Appeals will hear the applications tomorrow night at 8 o'clock at the town hall. The hearing will be held in the morning and will be open to the public.

Price Hearing On Tomorrow

Naugatuck Session to Be First of Two in Connecticut

Naugatuck, Sept. 24-25 - Selected as representative of Connecticut's smaller industrial communities, Naugatuck, cradle of the nation's rubber industry, tomorrow will be the scene of the first Connecticut probe of high prices by a subcommittee of the Joint Congressional Committee on the Economic Report.

Only two members of the subcommittee, Senator Raymond E. Baldwin (R., Conn.) and Rep. Robert G. Rich (R., Penn.) are planning to take part in the Naugatuck hearing, according to Leslie T. Fossell, Baldwin's administrative assistant and chief clerk.

Fossell, who identified the prospective witnesses, said the list was tentative. The hearing will open at 9:45 a. m. at the state judges room, and Fossell said it was hoped that the committee would complete its local business by 5 p. m.

Fossell said witnesses would be permitted to submit written statements but that no time would be allowed for the reading of such statements at the hearing.
