No Casualties Arab World's Troops Moving to Seal Off Palestine Frontiers

On Iwo Jima; Much Damage Vicious Typhoon Howls Across Island for 36 Hours at Speeds Reaching 170 Miles

Two Jima, Oct. 10.—(AP)—Wind-whipped Arab soldiers and their dependents were seen to be in a storm shelter this morning after 36 hours of rain and wind across the island.

Correspondents flying here from Iwo Jima reported that the storm shelter was in a state of disrepair and that the island was a wasteland.

Damage to installations was extensive. The winds smashed like giant hands on roofs of buildings, ripped out the island's inner communications lines and smashed the flagpole.

The typhoon's greatest damage was done to the island's communications lines. At least six miles of the island's telephone lines were destroyed.
