King Wants to Retire As Leader of Canada's Liberal Party

Ottawa, Jan. 22.—(AP)—Prime Minister William Lyon Mackenzie King says he wants to retire as leader of Canada's dominant Liberal party, and thus—according to tradition—become prime minister, as soon as the party names his successor.

In an address before the National Liberal Federation's Advisory Council Tuesday night, he asked that the Liberal convention be summoned next summer to select his successor, as the party's boss.

Political circles interpreted the 70-year-old prime minister's carefully qualified remarks to mean that he wants to get out of office this year, but that he would consent to being drafted if the country needs him further.

Would Surpass Empire Breed King, who has been in office for all but five and a half years since Dec. 29, 1921, would by April 20, 1948, surpass the empire record for length of prime ministerial service, set up by Robert Walpole of Britain, who served for 7,619 days early in the 18th century as head of Britain's government.

Foreign Trade To Be Studied

Board of Inquiry Will Make Survey Regarding State Participation

New Haven, Jan. 22.—(AP)—Executive Secretary John DeWitt Norton has announced that the Connecticut committee, composed of representatives of important statewide organizations, has named a board of inquiry to study Connecticut's participation in foreign trade as a basis for better understanding the state's role under the Marshall plan, the international trade organization and the reciprocal trade agreements program.

The Connecticut committee was established last year, said Norton, for the purpose of developing "a common understanding of current problems and policies by means of the joint consultation of representatives of the important statewide organizations."

Committee's First Project The study of Connecticut's role in foreign trade is the committee's first project.

Comprising the board of inquiry are: Charles M. Lyman of New Haven, president of the State Bar Association; Leonard Bright of Bridgeport, representing the Connecticut Federation of Labor; Edward Barnham of Bristol, Connecticut Manufacturers association; president; L. S. Hough of Collinsville, vice president of the American Association of University Women; Anson T. Cook of Hartford, member of the Hartford City Council and national official of the American Legion.

Also Miss Wanda Pitt of Hartford, representing the Textile Workers of America (CIO); Thomas J.
