Support of 'Y' Before Board

If town would pay Director's Salary It Could Operate

The town will underwrite the cost of a director, the YMCA may be able to care for its buildings and continue the other parts of its program, the Board of Directors heard last night. Action on the matter was deferred pending further investigation of connected financial matters.

Director Sherwood G. Bowers reported for the joint committee of directors, YMCA officials and citizens who met last Friday to go over the question of town management, suggested by the YMCA, a way out of looming financial difficulties. The YMCA, which established the center, depends on public subscription for much of its current work. Support by donation has not kept pace with expenses, it was said.

It had been thought that the program on a public use basis, if the town would take over the program and conduct the recreation center, provided the full assets of the YMCA as a condition of its management.

Director Bowers said that at the committee meeting, after consideration of the various aspects of the case "it came out" that if the town would stand the cost of employment of a director, the Y. M. C. A. might out of the funds be able to continue building up and other non-theatrical activities.

There was some question raised, Bowers said, whether any plan might be effective under terms of a legal plan of operation reported on by General Manager George H. Waddell, indicates that a legal plan of operation might be effective.

Director Bowers said that there was question if, by furnishing the Y. M. C. A. a director, the town might not be spending public money for a private interest, but after discussion, it was agreed that if the town actually established another recreation center and fully operated that part of the program, the Board of Directors accepted the Bowers report as one of progress for further committee meetings and legal investigation on the subject will follow.

The time may have come for the United States to announce a definite and definitive policy, based on a calm, thoughtful realization of its own strength, and saying, in effect, two things to Russia. Dr. George McCreynolds, head of the department of government at the University of Connecticut, told an audience here last night. Dr. McCreynolds' appearance was sponsored by the Manchester branch of the Hartford County Y.W.C.A.

Dr. McCreynolds said that we should clearly define to Russia a line beyond which any advance would be considered a threat to our own security, and that we should stand firm in that line. He said that we are now ready and will always be ready to negotiate and seek agreement on all matters between the two countries. He said that the American position is in the world today.

Involved in World Problems. Noting that America today, in contrast to the America of ten years ago, has abandoned isolationism and has become a world power, he listed and described the various world problems in which this nation is now involved.

Dr. McCreynolds said a second line must be drawn in regard to the nationalistic movements in southern Asia, where our policy must be either to support or not to support such nationalistic aspirations. He said that the United States should be regarded as the major victor in the Pacific.

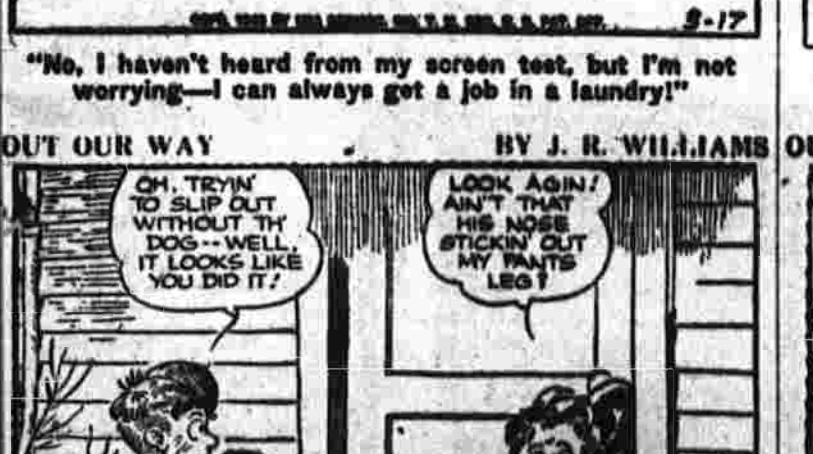

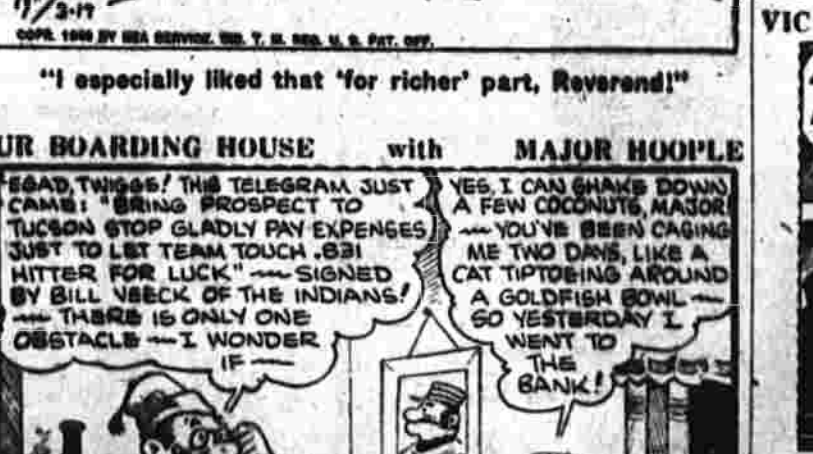
