Reelect Milne To City Post
 Supt. of Public Works Received All Votes of Common Council

Rockville—(Special) Superintendent of Public Works, George E. Milne, was reelected for the second year term at the meeting of the Common Council held Tuesday evening, receiving all twelve votes of the Council. Superintendent Milne is a Republican and there had been some speculation as to whether or not he would receive the reelection by the Council composed of ten Democrats and two Republicans. Mr. Milne has done an outstanding job during the past winter with the snow removal and his appointment will meet with approval.

The other officers elected at last night's meeting are all new: Corporation Counsel Attorney Robert Peason; Health officer, Dr. Frank Burke; Tax Collector, Thomas Regan; Haul Maker, Mrs. Katherine Moran. The last two offices are for the term of one year only. Three petitions will meet with approval.

The council authorized the mayor to enter into an agreement with the State Highway Commissioner in regard to funds which will be available for the city for the repaving and improvement of highways. Mayor Frederick Berger stated that he talked with the State Aid Agent and that \$18,000 would be available for the city's use between July 1, 1948, and July 1, 1949.

A communication was read from Metcalf & Eddy in regard to the surveys for the sewer project and this was referred to the Corporation Council.

Upon the recommendation of Alderman Harry Eitel, the publication of the Health Survey of the city, taken under the direction of Yale University last year, was discussed and it was voted that it be published by the lowest bidder at an approximate cost of \$175. The question of bills being presented in advance of the Council meetings was discussed. It was voted that all bills be in the hands of the Council members at 6 p. m. on Monday previous to the meeting of they will not be paid for two weeks.

Hospital's Blood Bank Here In Operation Over a Year

Manchester Memorial hospital is one of the few hospitals in the state that has an active blood bank in operation.

The Manchester hospital blood bank has been operating successfully for over a year. It was started in March of 1947 and in a year's time 548 blood transfusions have been made.

The bank has been able to supply them.

When the bank was established a drive was made for volunteer donors. The Red Cross and the Manchester Herald and other organizations supported the drive and several hundred volunteers were obtained.

The hospital administration and the medical staff deeply appreciate the cooperation of the volunteer donors. Without them the program could not succeed.

Ready for Emergencies

The purpose of this bank is to insure enough blood for the hospital at all times to cope with any emergency.

The bank is kept in operation by voluntary donors, plus patients who secure their own blood from either their immediate families or friends to keep the bank constantly supplied. Voluntary donors furnish blood to the bank for patients who are unable to secure donors or have exhausted their individual donor list.

Only on a few occasions has it been necessary for a family to purchase blood. These have been cases in which rare types of blood have been needed.

By keeping the blood bank up to its full quota, all of which is drawn during the day, no patient's family is put to the resultant hardship of being called to give blood during the night in an emergency. Patients can draw from the bank in any emergency and their families are contacted at a later date to replace blood.

When Transfusions Needed

Blood transfusions are given to patients suffering from Leukemia, Anemia, Bleeding Ulcers, Post-partum Hemorrhage, Post-operative Bleeding, Severe Bleeding Accident cases and Erythroblastosis fetalis.

After a donor volunteers blood the laboratory technicians type his blood. Only types "A" and "O"

North Carolina Hit by Tornado

Charlotte, N. C., March 24--(AP)—A thickly populated section of North Carolina escaped serious damage last night when a tornado roared across the state.

The twister struck first in Mecklenburg county, near the South Carolina border. It continued a threatening northeasterly course at a high altitude for more than 100 miles, across the state's heavily industrialized Piedmont section.

Three of North Carolina's larger cities, Salisbury, High Point and Greensboro, were in the path of the high winds. Radio warnings alerted residents along the storm's course but the twister remained above 3,500 feet as it roared over those areas.

Three hours after striking near Charlotte and Concord, the tornado crossed into Virginia where it apparently dissipated itself.

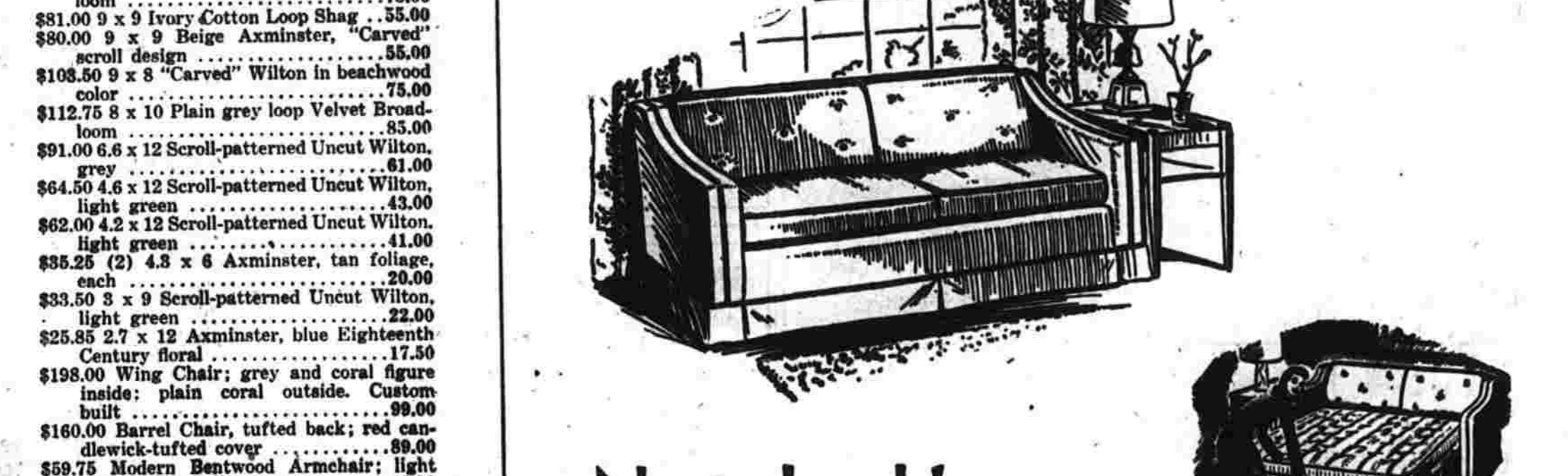
