**Voters Punch Ticket Today In Wisconsin**

Three Republican Presidential Aspirants Facing Primary Test; Ob- livion May Smack One

Bulletin:

Milwaukee, April 6.—Clear, cool weather prevailed throughout Wisconsin today as voters made their decision in the state's vital presidential election. The temperature, falling in the high 40s, and the light breeze for balls between delegates candidates for three Republican presidential aspirants.

Milwaukee, April 6.—(AP)—Wisconsin voters punch the tickets today on three Republican presidential aspirants.

Some politicians think it may be a toss-up between today's three candidates—Gen. Douglas MacArthur, Gov. Thomas E. Dewey of New York, and former Gov. Harvey E. Riss.

A result of polls in Milwaukee, Dewey was given more chance than previously to pull up among the contenders. Despite bear stories coming out of his headquarters, he might be the third man in the critical race.

Franchisees of all the politicians were agreed that MacArthur will be the first to get the nod, followed by Dewey and Riss. The latter two are expected to be in Honolulu when Dewey is expected to arrive in the state.

On the other hand, he could sweep the state's 27 G.O.P. electoral delegates and thus make himself the man to be reckoned with in the presidential primary one week from today.

A new spokesman, Judge Francis J. Brennan, said that MacArthur's chief administration setup in Japan, which camp's leadership in the Pacific states "Douglas MacArthur will win the primary by a landslide." He said that MacArthur's popularity will go into the Republican race.

**British, Russian Planes Collide Over Berlin**

United States Acts to Hold Arctic Areas

Also Moves Indirectly To Strengthen Norwegian Hold on Strategic Polar Islands Now

Washington, April 6.—(AP)—The United States moved directly today to bolster its position in the Arctic and to hold on to strategic strength Norway's hold on strategic Polar Islands.

The direct action was signaled by Joint Army and Air Force plans to restore for all but military use a string of Alaskan islands. These stretch out in a loop around the tip of Alaska, from Kachikha and the Kurils. They lead over the approach to Detroit Harbor, which the Japanese attacked along with Pearl Harbor.

Action on the other front came in the Navy's announcement that the U. S. carrier task force will be the Newcarter port of Bergen, April 20 to May 2, on a goodwill mission to the coast.

Both moves were described as "routine" by the State Department. But behind the "routine" label was the background: The U. S. Secretary of Defense Forrestal reported two weeks ago that the Navy had a fleet of only 7,000 troops and less than 100 fighter planes.
