Murray Awaiting Moves on Steel

A maze of rumors sprang up around the country about possible secret settlement of the strike that has idled more than a million and one half workers, but Murray brushed them all aside with; "They are without foundation," or "that simply isn't so." Iron Age magazine, a trade journal, said Murray's rejection of the industry's compromise offer at the last peace talks did not meet with approval of his union lieutenants. But union officials said Iron Age's report is without foundation

The issue of a union shop, which would require all workers to join the union, or some modified form of it appeared to be the big stumbling block in the path of a settlement in the past 24 hours, adding:
"The situation remains as 'it has been. I know of no plans for any further negotiating sessions."

Murray has called the steel-workers 170-man wage policy committee to meet in Pittsburgh Monday. That committee makes all major union decisions.

Murray said he will report on the strike and ask the group to map a course of future action.

Meanwhile the longest strike in steel history drifts along in its seventh week. It is costing the nation about 40 million dellars a day in lost wages and steel production

alone.
