





Off North Carolina (Continued from Page One)

A high pressure area moved over yesterday from the middle Atlantic and New England states to block the tropical storm away from the American coastline and it ground almost to a stop.

"If the hurricane is moving at all it is moving very, very slowly northward," said Miami's chief storm forecaster Grady Norton.

Highest winds, were estimated at 100 miles per hour over a small area to the northeast of the storm center. Gales extended outward 150 miles to the southwest and 250 miles to the north and east.

"Until the high pressure area moves out of the way," Norton said "we don't know what the hurricane will do."
