Schools Get \$7,000 Check

> Illing Receives Half of Federal Aid Grant on Operating Expenses

The Manchester school system oday received approximately half of what is is expected to get in federal aid for the schools' operat-ing expenses. Superintendent of Schools Arthur H. Illing reported this morning.
Illing said a check of \$7,236 was

received from the Federal Security Agency, Office of Education, in ac-cordance with the provision of Public Law 874 which provides for federal aid to schools in communi-ties having children living in Federal housing projects.

The total net figure Manchester is entitled to on the basis of the average daily attendance of chil-dren living in Silver Lane and Or-ford Village, the two federal housing projects in town, has been figured at \$14,472, Illing said. The second payment of government aid for operating expenses will be forwarded as soon as the government acts on the town's final report acts on the town a mai report of attendance figures. Hing-said the average daily attendance of chil-dren living in the projects is 33s. The money received today has nothing to do with federal aid for school building.
