



Boards of Education and Finance met in a joint three hour session Gets Extra \$1,556 last night for analysis of the proposed education budget for 1953-54. A final figure has not as yet been established aithough it is ex-pected to be in the neighborhood of \$105,000. of \$105,000.

This is an increase of approximately \$14,000 over last year's figure, increase in enrollment at the action is expected to total about 50 pupils. The biggest jump in individual budget items is for teachers' salaries, an increase of \$8.

### Gulf Stream Nearer Shore:

Exotic Marine Life Swirls To Waters off New London

New Haven, July 22—49—A—The Gulf Stream is surprisingly moted marine acientist said here today that the presence of exotic marine-life in waters adjacent to Long Island Sound and in the sound itself may not be so unusual.

They are due, said Prof. Daniel Merriman, director of Yale's Bingham Oceanographic Laboratory, to meanderings of the Gulf Stream, which he described as "surprisingly movable."

Dr. Merriman's statement came in an interview which sought to account for the presence of such species as the stingray, sea horses and cutlasshish in the waters off New London.

Stingray Injures Man—The Gulf Stream is surprisingly movable. It also, is not a single "stream," but several currents moving parallel to each other. At certain times of year it is distant from the coastline here; at others, it is closer. It is closest usually in August and mid-September. Sometimes it shifts its course slowly, other times rapidly.

When the shift is rapid, a "swirt" breaks from it, like an eddy, and the warm water carries with it the marine life that was in it when the break occurred.

Gioing On Long Time

It isn't something that has happened only this year, he says. It has been going on since earliest time. So-called sea horses have been found in the warm shallows of the lower New England coast-line for many years.




