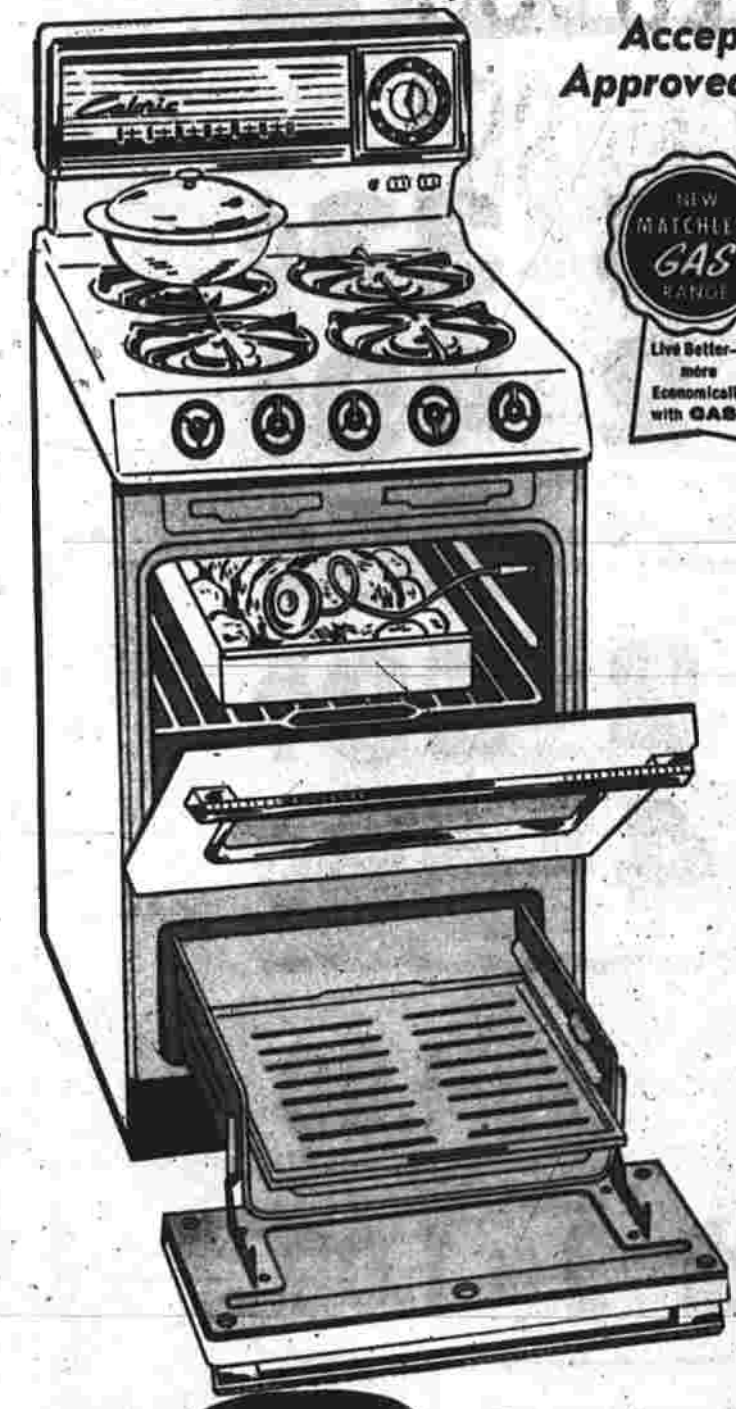

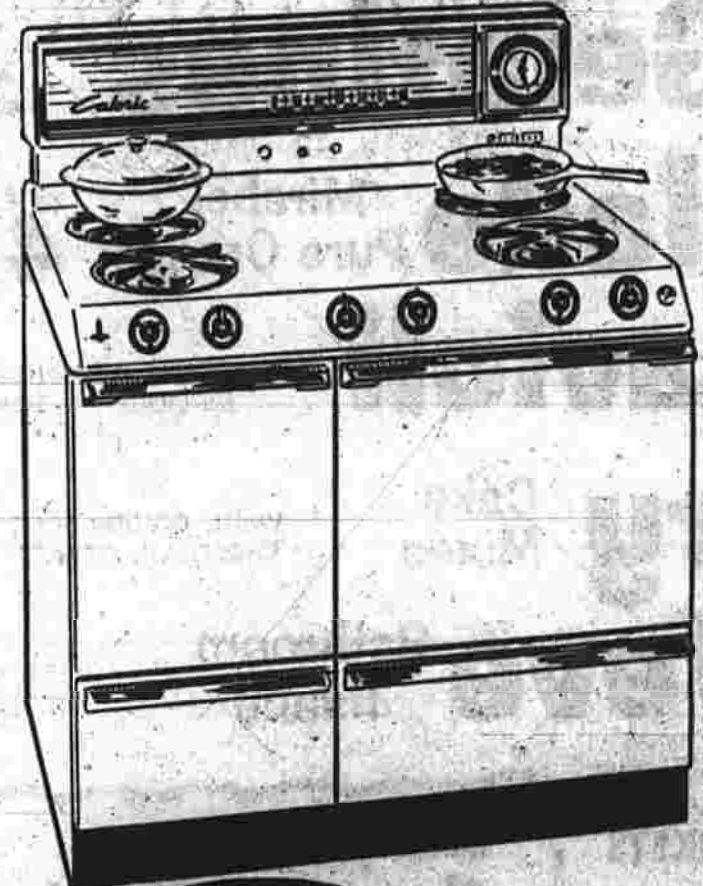

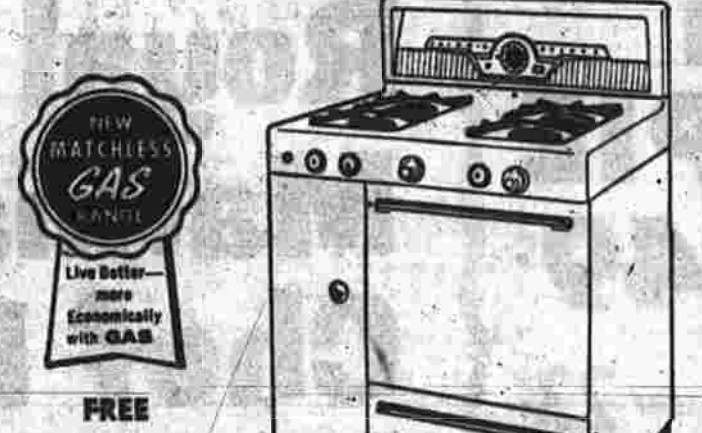

The Manchester Republican Town Committee is expected to elect its first woman chairman in history when it meets in the Municipal Building tonight.

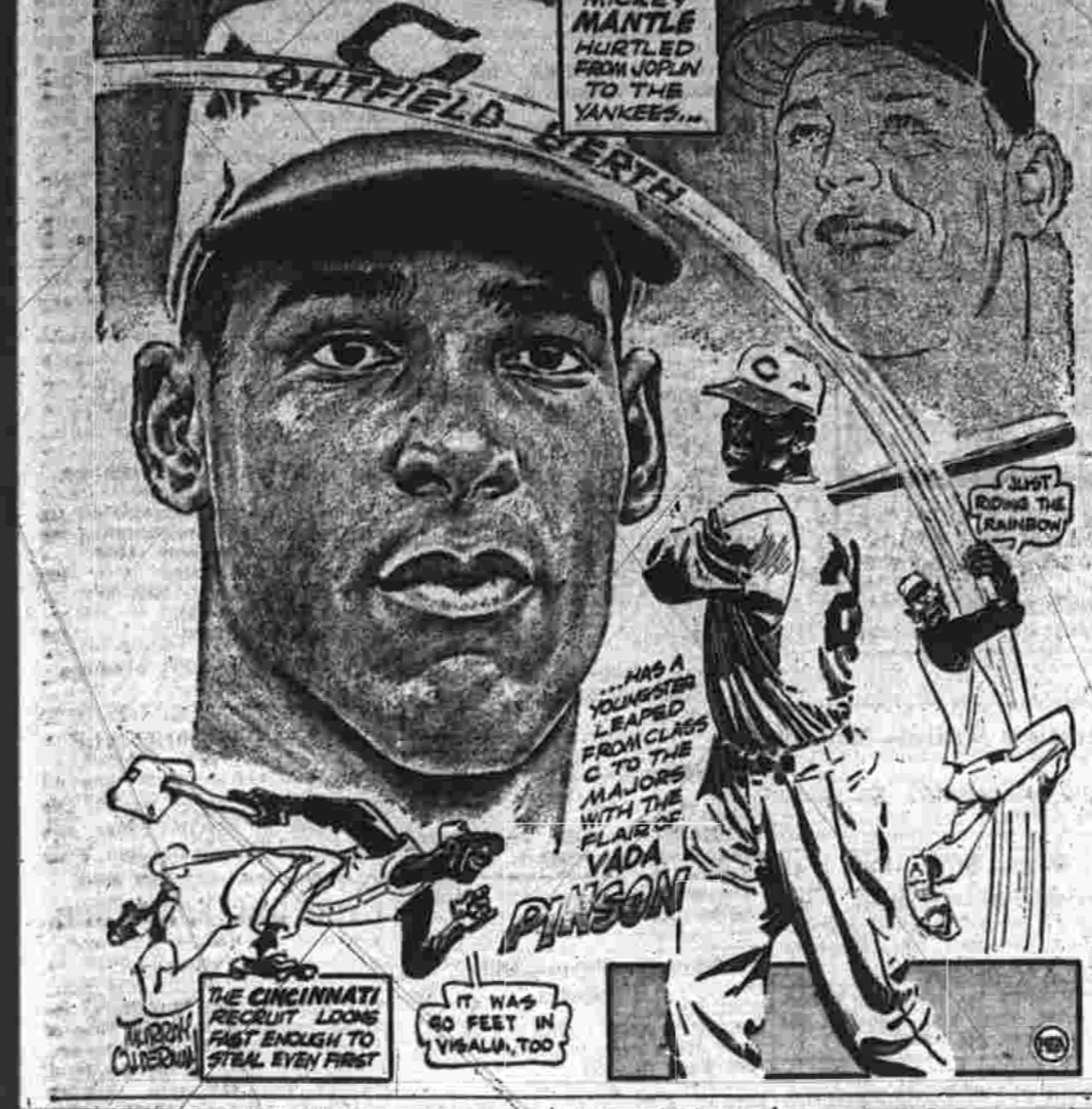
