## **Putting End** To Action

Washington, July 12 (P)— Rep. John Bell Williams (D-Miss) tendered a peace feeler to Bernard Goldfine today. He indicated a contempt citation may not be voted for some time-if at all. "We are not anxious to cite him," said Williams, a senior Democrat on a House subcommittee investigating relations between Bos-ton millionaire Goldfine and Sherman Adams, President Eisenhower's aide. Williams said "We are much

more anxious to get the informa-tion" about some of Goldfine's finances—information which Goldfine has refused to give so far on grounds it is not relevant to the

inquiry.

"There would be no need to cite him if we get the information," Williams said.

The Mississippi congressman said that although groundwork has been laid for a vote to cite Goldfine for contempt of Congress, the subcommittee is not likely to the subcommittee is not likely to act at least for a while. He said the subcommittee wants to com-plete the record first. Williams spoke in an interview as Goldfine was given a long weekend to ponder his troubles with the subcommittee and plan strategy for his scheduled reappearance on the witness stand Tuesday. Further questioning of Goldfine is expected to last two days, per-




