1,700 Marines Join Beirut Area Units

The 1,700 Marines joining the Beirut area units are being sent to take over internal security duties in the crown colony from the famed Red Devil Paratroopers sent there last week.

The great British aircraft carrier Eagle was due in waters between Cyprus and Lebanon.

The advance party of U.S. paratroopers from Turkey comprised 30 men headed by Col. Charles Partridge. He did not know when the 2,000-man lead force of the 24th Division, based in Turkey, would be sent from the Middle East.

Partridge said the Marines would take over from the British troops in Jordan, meanwhile still light without firing a shot but the U.S. intervention against mounting opposition in the Lebanese parliament.

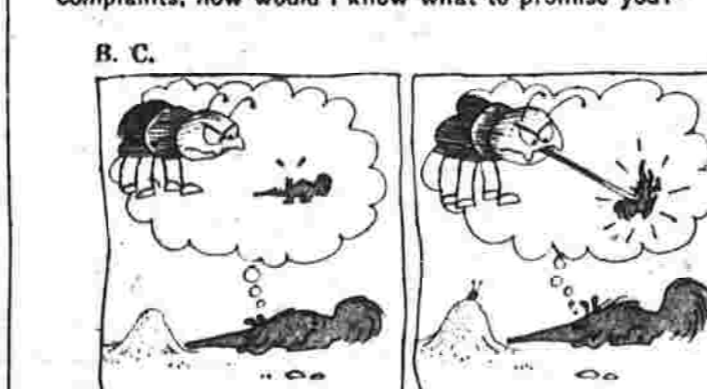

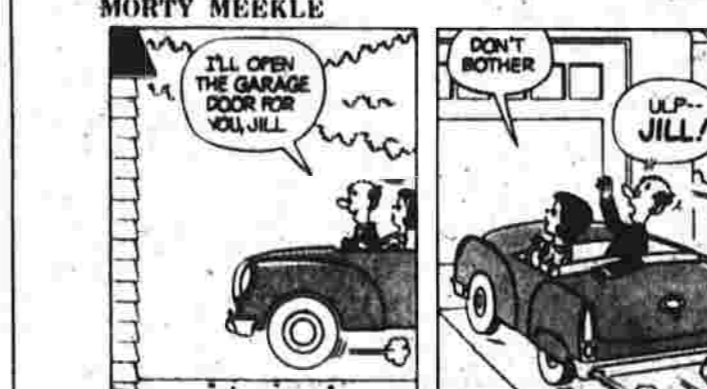

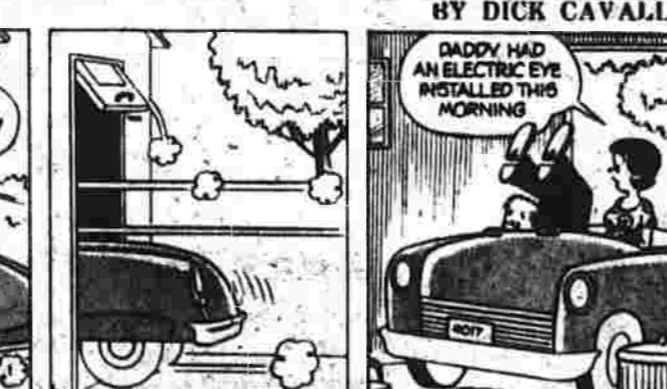
