### Have Man's Peace?

Last May it was the fear that Premier Pinchot might be called to undertake negotiations with the Algerian rebels which touched off the revolt of army and civilian in Algeria which toppled General de Gaulle to power.

Thursday Premier de Gaulle calmly and publicly invited the leaders of the Free Algerian Government to come to France and talk case-by-case, with no preconditions. Those French extremists in Algeria, who have never been able to understand anything except extermination of the Algerian revolt through the use of force, were so shocked that they raised their voices after the host de Gaulle has repeatedly said that he would end in disaster.

But the invitation was as real as it was calm, and there is a possibility that the rebel leaders may accept de Gaulle's call toward a "peace man's peace." They may want it because they may fear mortal and propaganda risk to the prestige of their cause if they do not accept it.

Here at any rate, it is possible de Gaulle is moving to see if he can end the second round of civil war in the Algerian situation. He has already asked the French extremists in Algeria, who merely want the old colonial order restored by the use of force, to soften those rebel extremists who have always proclaimed that they had nothing less than full independence of France. This may seem impossible. But it was possible, only last May, that a French president should be able to invite the rebels to a "peace man's peace."
