P&W AJT12 Will Power New JetStar

Pratt & Whitney Aircraft's new small, high-performance jet turbine engine—the JT12—will power the engine, 600-mile-an-hour Lockheed JetStar aircraft, which is being developed for military utility fleets and corporate use.

The JT12 weighs only 300 pounds and develops 3,000 pounds of static thrust. The small Lockheed transport is to power a fleet of corporate planes that will have a normal range of 1,800 miles.

The Air Force is interested in the JetStar for fast transport of troops and cargo. Pratt & Whitney Aircraft engines have already placed orders with Lockheed for the transportation of executives.

The company's JT12 and 175 engines power many of the U.S. Air Force and Navy front-line planes, as well as most of the new commercial jet airliners.

The swept-wing JetStar, which is in production at Lockheed Aircraft Corp.'s Marietta, Ga., plant, is 38 feet long, 20.5 feet high, with a 60-foot wingspan.

The JT12 engine will be placed in two positions on each engine nacelle. The aim of this design is to provide safety, comfort and ease of maintenance according to Lockheed officials.

Remble Aviation Corp. last fall selected the JT12 for an advanced "jet" new under development for the Army. Besides its suitability for drone and commercial military aircraft, the JT12 is also suited for missile and helicopter applications, according to Pratt & Whitney.

League Gets Fluoridation Report Today

Wilbur Bennett, president of the Manchester Taxpayers League, said today he is virtually certain that 1,000 signatures will be counted tonight when a League petitioners report the results of a 6-day drive for a referendum on fluoridation.

Early reports, Bennett said, showed 600 signatures had been obtained at the start of the week-end. Aron captains will phone the latest results tonight to Bennett's home at 98 McKee St.

Bennett said if the count tonight is 1,000 or less the League will push on toward 1,300 to provide a cushion against the rule that 5 per cent of the town's registered voters must sign in order to force a referendum.

He said totals are unknown now because many friends of League members are circulating petitions on their own. Tonight's count will be the first thorough one of the canvass that began last Tuesday.

His GOP Stand. Menerville Bennett has lashed out at the Republican Town Committee for voting to support fluoridation at a meeting last Friday night. Bennett said the committee "had no business getting involved in this non-political matter, and fluoridation is a very personal issue to each individual."

The League is not opposing fluoridation in principle but the fact that it was passed here without a public hearing at which townspeople might have expressed themselves on the matter, Bennett said.
