Eisenhower to Get Push Toward Talk On Berlin Impasse

Washington, Jan. 31 (AP)—The Eisenhower Administration apparently is in line for some sharp prodding from the Senate to move toward a higher level of negotiations with Russia on the Berlin impasse. This was clearly indicated at a Senate hearing today on the important Senate Foreign Relations Committee.

Calling for East-West talks on the German problem, Fulbright said he thinks it would be "quite proper" to enter into discussions of the withdrawal of troops from Berlin.

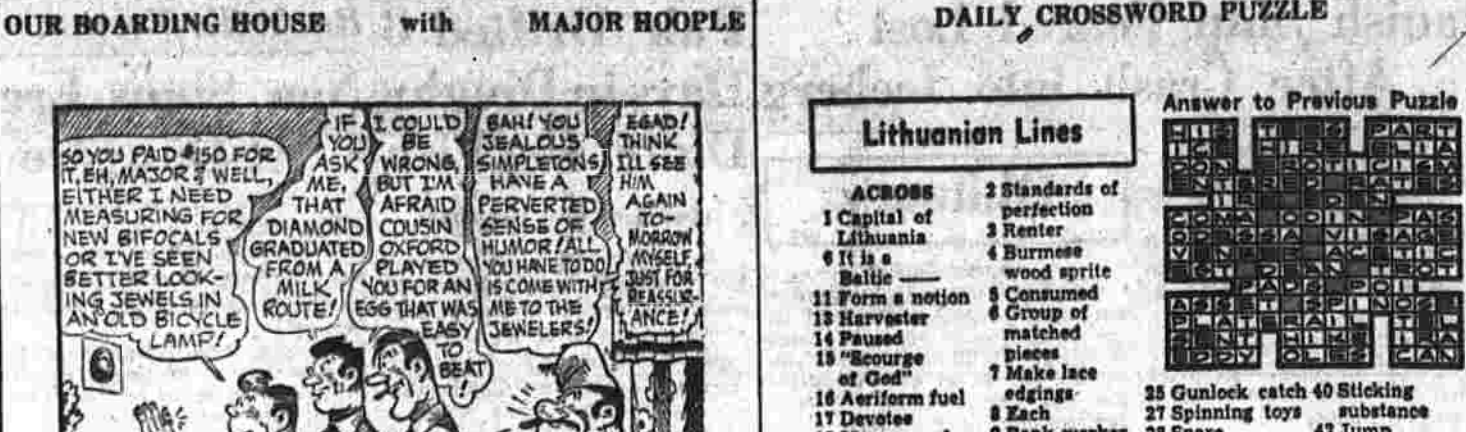
