Jobless Totals Again Near 5 Million Mark

By NORMAN WALKER Washington, Feb. 9 (AP)—Unemployment is climbing back close to the five million mark, economists reported today. They said a figure approaching that mark may be shown in the government's January count, due out tomorrow.

Joblessness normally rises in the winter months because of the weather's effect on construction, farm and other outdoor activities. The five million mark has not been exceeded since last April, when the jobless count was 5,120,000.

Operated by American Airlines, the plane crashed into the East River here just before midnight while approaching LaGuardia Field on instruments flight of the 73 persons aboard survived.

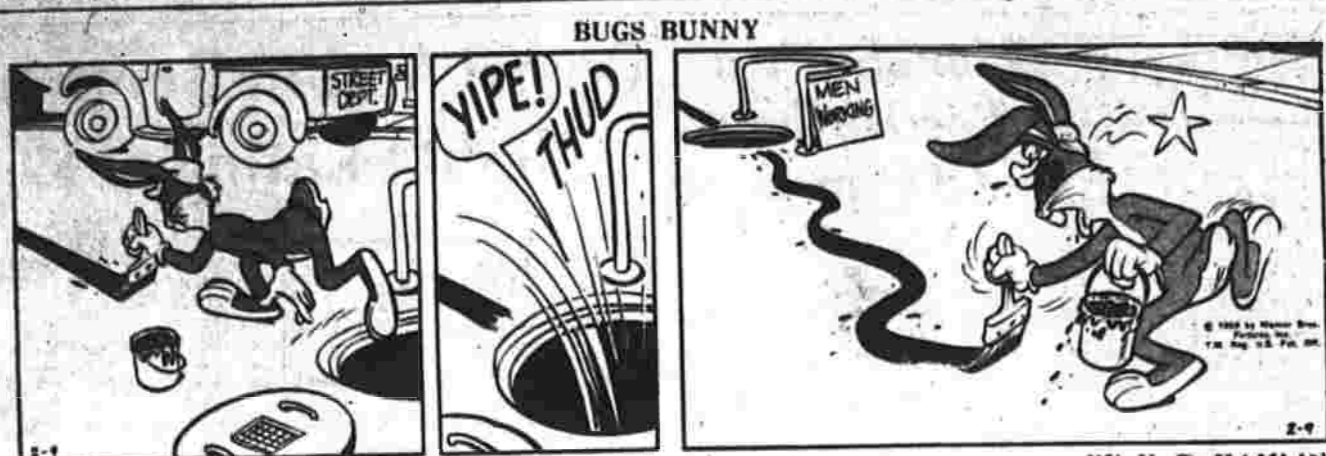

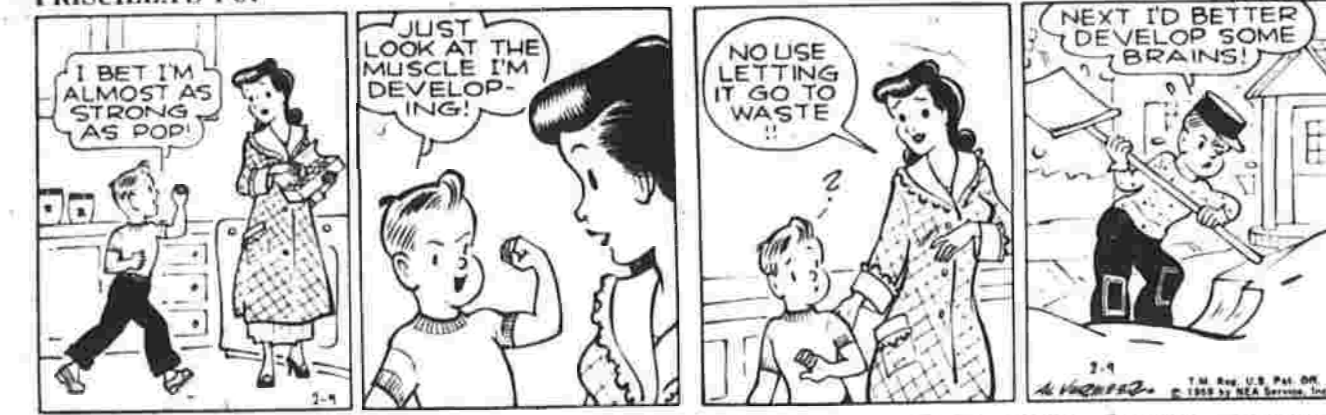

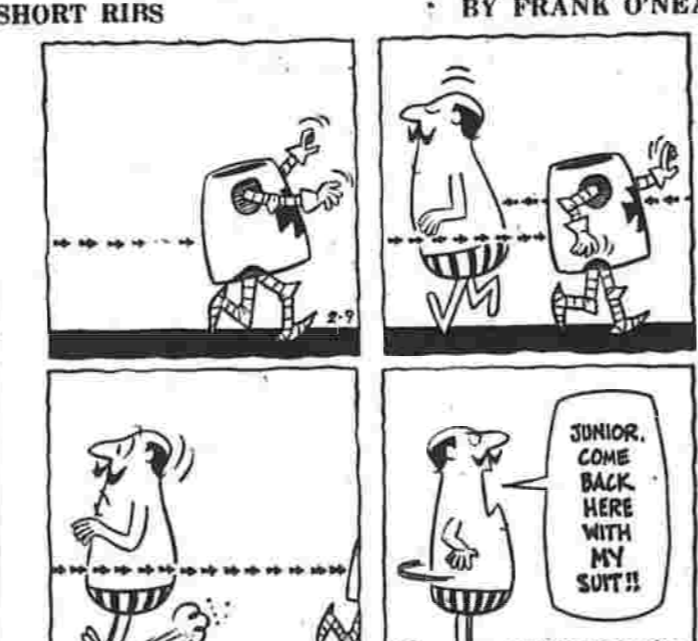
