Well balanced Manchester High School retained its team championship and senior Bob Ballard shared individual honors in the annual State C-IAC (Connecticut Intercollegiate Athletic Conference) Golf Championship yesterday afternoon over the 35-hole, 7,200 yard course at the Edgewood Golf Club in Fairfield. A record 32 men competed.

Coach Larry Perry's captain Red Smith, Ballard, Roger Fox and Alan McFarland wound up with an aggregate score of 227 in the four-man team. Ballard (53) and Roger Fox (52) shared runner-up honors with scores of 77 and 78, respectively. Both the Indians and Ballard finished 12th and 13th, respectively, in the individual competition. Ballard's score was one stroke better than Fox's and eight strokes better than the runner-up, William Grant, Jr. who finished 18th.

Other schools among the top 10 were Hartford (23), Waterbury (24), Farmington (24), Wallingford (24), Danbury (25), Westford (25), Storrs (25), and Middletown (25).

Pitchers Must Work on Control

My best advice to a young pitcher is that he stay cool and deliver fast balls, curves and screwball and knuckleball. A pitcher should learn to control himself.

He must practice getting the ball over the plate, starting out, a boy's best pitch should be fast ball. It has the most control. Unless you get the two you may never acquire control. Get your pitch in the proper zone.
