most all-out decisions which seem to seek an unconditional surrender, and leave no room for conciliation, compromise or a truce.

When the element of life or death is introduced, the result must be to strengthen and unify the union itself, and sooner or later, swing the public back toward the union cause.

It is not cynical and practically speaking, if the industry had really wanted to weaken and discredit the union, it would have done so by negotiating the same little wage agreement, the union, in its desire to avoid a strike, would have taken that. That would have been a partial victory over the union, and could have been obtained. The kind of victory now being sought is not likely to be obtained, and may lead to a more serious and more prolonged fight for management than for labor.

In any case, the nation neither wants nor needs such an all-out struggle. It wants each side fairly treated and each side to be respected in its own prerogatives, and where it concedes adjustments are needed to keep the balance, it wants them to be reached through negotiation and evolution rather than through any extended test which if persisted in, must lead to crippling both the economic vitality and the peace of the nation.

The end result was a pile of hydrophone records and other research data that all but blocked the cabin of Venn's chief scientist, Dr. John E. Mearns—and similar piles of records on the other ships. It will take six months to work through the data.

That job is done, however, the survey scientists will not only know whether a suitable site for the hydrophone Mohole project has been found. They will have located an important area in the map of the world's biggest and nearest underwater frontier—the ocean floor.

Pathologists say the cause of the flock is unknown nor is any ready cure available. The disease strikes plants without warning. Authorities believe it may be caused by insects in shipment, air polluted by factory waste and an increase in automobile exhaust fumes.

Hartford, July 22 (AP)—Stockholders of both companies have approved the merger of the Thompsonville Trust Co. with the Connecticut Bank and Trust Co.

The merger, which would be effective Aug. 3, now must be approved by state and federal banking authorities. Under terms of the merger, 3 1/2 percent of Connecticut Bank and Trust stock are to be exchanged for each share of Thompsonville Trust Co.

The stockholders approved the merger at separate meetings yesterday. Holders of more than two-thirds of all outstanding stock in both banks voted.

The Thompsonville and Somers offices of the Thompsonville Trust Co. are to become branch offices of the Connecticut Bank and Trust Co. under the merger.

The smaller bank has resources of more than \$12 million, while the bigger company's nearly \$428 million in resources.

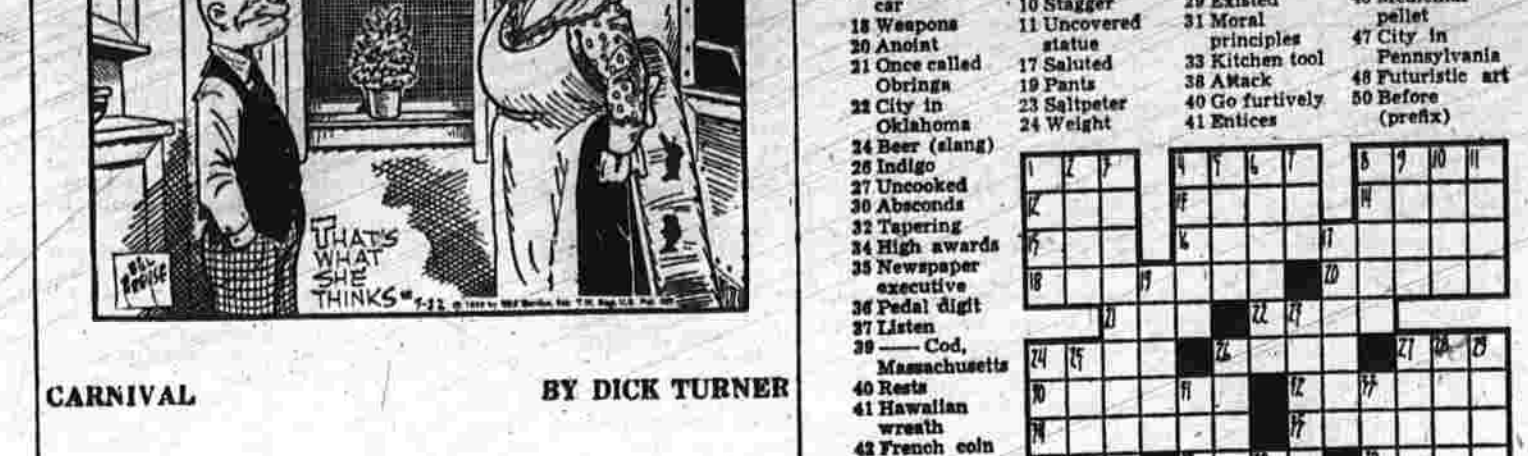
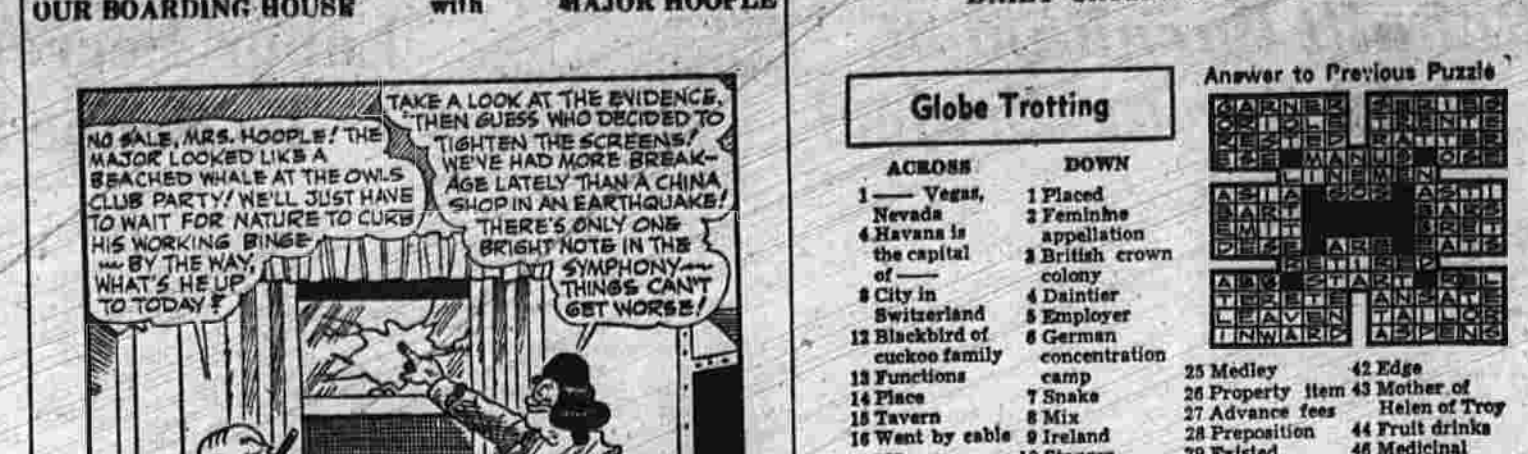
