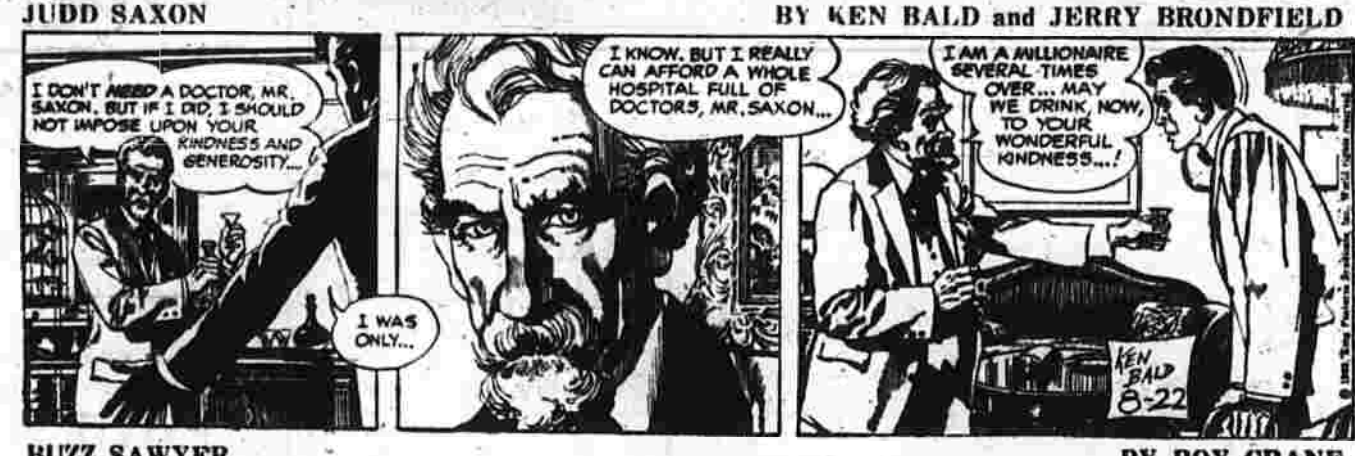

As a two-times Town Director, Kelly has never volunteered a statement to the press. He keeps out of squabbles in the news columns and, when political charges are made against him, he "pulls Ribicoffs"—that is, he doesn't reply.

He's a cooperative off-the-record speaker. But officially, he's more than tight-lipped.

Maybe he thinks news aggressives issues. Maybe he thinks news, or the way it's handled, creates more noise than events merit in some cases and does more harm than good.

In some cases, truth could be found in these opinions. It could be found also in the opinion that public officials can learn to use the press honestly and wisely as an instrument for testing public opinion and creating climates in advance of ideas or plans.

Some observers might say one expert in such uses is General Manager Richard Martin.

But whatever the reasons for Kelly's gunshyness, he sometimes lets it go too far. He deprives his public of a good story.

This seemed to be revealed at a Board of Directors meeting last Tuesday night. Another Town Director was saying she had visited recently regraded Robertson Park many times and was indicating that she deserved some credit for her visits and her interest in the announcement that he himself once rode a bicycle through the underground conduit that encloses Lydall Brook through the park.

have been as flat as the brook waters themselves. But maybe Kelly was kidding. He's sharp-witted under his bushy basket.
