The percentage either is a record or must be close to one for the many years Ring has been rating top fighters.

In the latest monthly ratings, released today, fighters from outside of the U. S. held four belts in the heavyweight division, headed by World Champion Ingemar Johansson of Sweden; six in the light heavyweight class; two in the middleweight division; four in the welterweight division; three in the lightweight division; and all 11 in both the bantamweight and flyweight classes.
