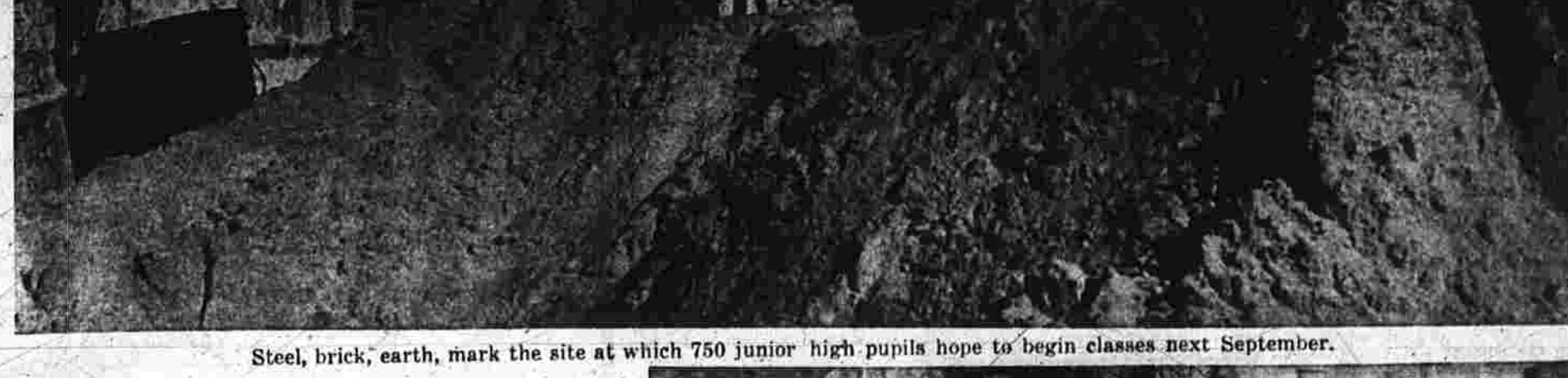

Our Ideals And Our Canal... The Canal fever across the Cox, the world-wide stir of opinion toward unclouded freedom and dignity, and, above all, the background of the success of Nasser in nationalizing the Suez Canal, have all probably played some part in producing the general sentiment in Panama which led to this week's anti-American riots there.

Dream Came Through for Thornton

Some boys dream of being firemen when they grow up. Others picture themselves as policemen of the future. Many youngsters fancy themselves as jet pilots and rocketmen when they reach maturity. In Billy Thornton's case, it was different. He wanted to play golf. He was sure that some day he would be a golf professional.

Star in School
