The most recent count shows there are more than 7,500,000 Lutherans in the United States divided into 17 church bodies, ranging from the tiny Eleison Synod's 1,600 baptised members to the United Lutheran Church's 2,400,000.

When mergers currently underway are accomplished the number of Lutheran bodies will be reduced to 12.
