# Summit Talks in April West Germany, France Agree

(Continued from Page One)

After the news conference, Adenauer returned to the French presidential palace for closing talks with De Gaulle before returning to Germany tonight.

With only an interpreter present, the two leaders got down to business after their foreign ministers had worked over issues on which they agree and disagree.

It was understood that the two would be in conference most of the day, until Adenauer's departure early tonight for Bonn.

The second day of Adenauer's visit was greeted by French headlines hailing the positive friendship between West Germany and France and the close relations that have developed between the two statesmen.

The French yesterday renewed their assurance to Adenauer that De Gaulle would insist at any summit conference on a Berlin settlement only as part of an overall German reunification settlement.

One of Adenauer's biggest worries has been that the West German case of Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchov's threats to West Berlin would agree on an isolated Berlin settlement. However, De Gaulle has always sided with Adenauer on this.

The Superior Court can send Uphaus to jail unless he purges himself by answering Wyman's questions. "In any case this may mean a life sentence," Uphaus has said.

Despite a flood of telegrams and letters urging clemency, Gov. Wesley Powell declined to commute the court's decision to banish John Wesley Uphaus from the state.

Uphaus attributed his refusal to religious convictions, conscience and the direct teachings of the Bible that it is wrong to bear false witness.

"Inasmuch as I have no reason to believe that any of these persons whose names have been called for have in any sense hurt this state or our country," he said, "I have reason to believe they should not be in the possession of the attorney general."

# Board Votes \$28,500 For School Repairs

The Board of Directors last night approved a \$28,500 appropriation for immediate renovations to the building.

The total recommended by the Building Committee was a little more than one half of the amount recommended by the Board of Education two months ago.

Repairs and additions to the heating systems at Hollister St. and Nathan Hale Schools will cost \$5,500. Preparations of plans and specifications for the Barnard Junior High School renovation will cost \$22,000.

Both of these costs were figured by the Building Committee Nov. 17 as part of a sweeping program of renovation in the schools.

### Storm Handling Plans Detailed by Selectmen

Plans for handling winter storms were announced by the Board of Selectmen today. The new features added include stockpiling of 2,000 yards of sand at the town garage. The sand, mixed with salt, will be available to residents who want to go to the garage to fill or replenish containers.

A man will be stationed at the garage during storms to loan sanding trucks and to receive trouble calls. A telephone was installed at the garage a few months ago. Snowplow operators will keep in telephone contact with the garage during storms to learn of emergency situations in their areas.

Barrels containing sand and salt mixture have already been placed on most hills for emergency use.

At the beginning of a storm, highway workers will spread straight salt at intersections and on hills. They will then follow the plows with sand and salt mixture during and after storms. Stanley Paterson and Elmer Wilson will work on sanding operations. The town pickup truck will also be used.

The town has been divided into four sections for plowing. Leonard Giglio will handle the northeast section which is bounded on the west by Quarry Rd., on the north and east by Rt. 8, Myron Lee will handle the northwest section bounded by Quarry, North and Clark Rds. on the east, the town line on the north and west and the town line on the south. Michael Pappo will plow the southeast section, bounded by Rt. 8 on the north, the town line on the east and south and Rt. 85, Clark and North Rds. on the west. The town truck will do the south west, or Birch Mountain area. This is bounded on the north and east by the town line, on the south and west.
