### Dentist Fined For Padding Welfare Bills

Hartford, Dec. 24 (AP)—A Manhattan dentist has been convicted and fined on four counts of defrauding the public community. Dr. Joseph S. Bell, 37, a former dental consultant in the Welfare Department, was accused of padding the bills of 11 welfare patients by \$2 to \$8 each. Superior Court Judge John P. Cotter, yesterday fined Dr. Bell \$200. The judge acquitted him of six felony charges of obtaining money by false pretenses. Judge Cotter also turned down the state's attorney's recommendation that Bell be fined \$200 and given a 1-year suspended term. "We can't be vindictive," said the judge.

Bell has got to face the State Dental Commission, which could revoke his license, or take no action. Judge Cotter said he hoped the commission would be lenient. While employed as a welfare consultant, Bell worked for Dr. David Weinstein, 44, of West Hartford. Four other dentists who worked with him were arrested along with Bell and Weinstein. They are Dr. Simon D. Landy, 41, of Newington; Dr. Edward Brostein, 46, of West Hartford; Dr. Irving Rosenberg, 39, of Newington; and Dr. Allyn A. Martin, 37, of Hartford. Weinstein and Landy recently pleaded no contest to criminal charges. They have not been sentenced. The others have asked for trial. The State charges Weinstein with defrauding at least \$1,000 during a 3-year period by charging for non-existent fillings, extractions, and other dental work. Weinstein last year received about \$35,000 in payments from the Welfare Department, the State said.

### Civil War Vet Laid to Rest

Franklin, Tex., Dec. 24 (AP)—The frail body of Walter Williams, the last veteran of the Civil War, yesterday was committed to the red clay soil of the Franklin Cemetery. Death is swallowed up in victory, said Chaplain Frederick Richardson of Ft. Hood, Tex., reading the burial service at the graveside rites for the 117-year-old Confederate soldier. There was a brief prayer as 2,000 stood with bowed heads under a heavily clouded sky. Three volleys by an honor guard echoed across the small, barbed-wire fenced cemetery. Then the notes of silver pipe rose and fell—the last taps to be sounded for the four million men who fought in the Civil War nearly a century ago. The simple graveside service near Williams' farm home in the Oak and Pine covered hills of central East Texas followed funeral services and a military procession through downtown Houston as a united nation paid final tribute to the former fought in Hood's brigade and Quantrell's Raiders who died Saturday.

### Prisoner to Tell Of Gang Slaying

Hartford, Dec. 24 (AP)—A state prison inmate will go to New Jersey next week to tell a grand jury what he knows about the gangland slaying of one of his friends. Superior Court Judge John P. Cotter yesterday agreed to let Louis Ferrini, 28, of Lond, N.J., appear before a Hudson County, N.J., grand jury. Ferrini will leave Monday and he may stay until Jan. 11 if necessary. Ferrini is now serving a four to 10 year term in the Connecticut State Prison for larceny. He was sentenced earlier this year in the slaying of fashionable homes in Connecticut's Fairfield County. Ferrini told Judge Cotter he was a close friend of the slain man, Joseph Baritto, and that he was an eyewitness to Baritto's death Nov. 12, 1958. The slaying is as yet unsolved.

# Death Claims Lord Halifax

Lord Halifax died at his country home here in Yorkshire last night. The grant, says British statesman who helped swing the might of the United States against Nazi Germany in World War II was 78.

Former viceroy to India, foreign secretary and wartime British ambassador to Washington, Lord Halifax had served all of his public offices with his integrity, his idealism and his ability. A conservative, deeply religious man once called an appeaser of Hitler for his association with the Munich peace policy of Prime Minister Neville Chamberlain. Halifax went on to serve Winston Churchill's campaign that triumphed over the Axis powers. Halifax declared defiantly in 1940: "We shall not stop fighting till freedom, for ourselves and others, is assured."

He went to the United States in the following year as ambassador. His mission was to persuade Americans, then on the sidelines, to swing their sympathies toward Britain, fighting alone against Hitler and a Anglo-American relations. "He is particularly remembered for his dedicated service to the cause of humanity during the crucial World War II years."

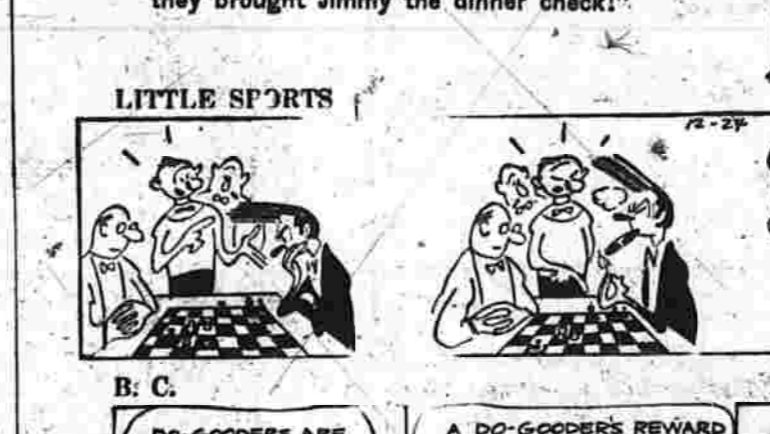
