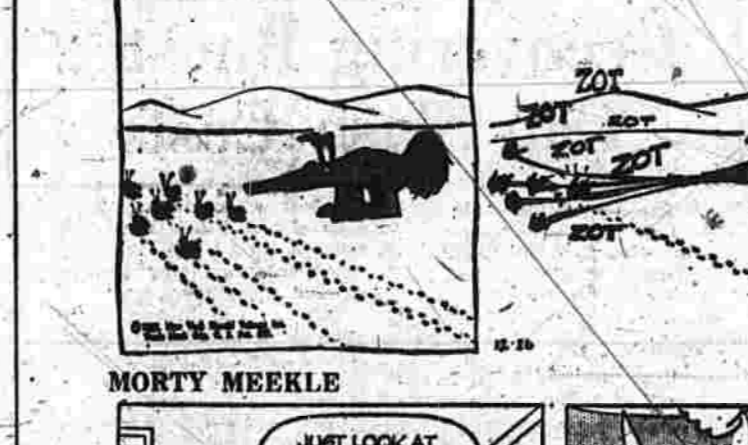

Byrnes New Hero Of 'Hep' Generation

"Way Out with Kookie."
This is the name of a magazine so new it's the "latest." It's a magazine written by Edd "Kookie" Byrnes for the "Jive Talking" generation. Edd is the new hero of this "hep" generation. He's Edward Byrnes, handsome 26-year-old, six feet, 165 pound, blue-eyed brown-haired teenage idol.

Stardom has a way of being awarded with startling suddenness on television these days and zooms hitherto unknown actors into public spotlight before the film for their test has been hung to dry.

Such is the story of Edd Byrnes who shares top billing with Efrem

Zimballat Jr., and Roger Smith in ABC-TV's "77 Sunset Strip" series. Started at 15

Don't think for one minute that Edd isn't fully cognizant of the fact that he may be considered a 7-day wonder and could just as soon fade away. But here lies the real story of Edd and his most assured successful future.

"There seems to be an idea floating around TV circles," said Edd, "that I'm just another one of those 7-day wonders who catapulted to stardom strictly on a gimmick—the hair-combing and jive talk bits, that is. Don't get me wrong," he said, "I'm not discounting the almost unbelievable surge these bits have given my career, but judged by present-day standards, I could be considered a seasoned veteran. Let's see. I'm 26. I started working seriously toward a theatrical career when I was 18. And, according to my mathematics, that's an 8-year span devoted almost entirely to preparation to this profession."

This awareness of the suddenness of his rise to fame and the possible consequent fall, as well as an appreciation of the part for good he can play in his role as a teenage idol, will stand him in good stead for any trials and tribulations which are very often the lot of the "nouveau riche" Hollywood actors.

Edd's recent successes, in the estimation of this reporter, will never collapse, but instead, continue to grow. He has already laid foundations which, if he maintains them, will bear him up under the most trying conditions. These foundations are a serious hardworking attitude, an awareness of the pitfalls and a consciousness of the great influence for the good that he can accomplish.

A graduate of Haaren High School (1951) in Manhattan, he became interested in the theater as a career through a friendship with Inge Puteh, a ballet dancer, who encouraged him to go on a casting roll for Joe E. Brown's "Bulck Circus Hour."

He was cast as an Indian on this show and made \$125. This was his first professional job. His next was with Jean Louis Barrault



Co. at the Ziegfeld Theater in New York. He carried a spear in the production of "Hamlet" and received \$5 a performance. He later appeared in their production of "The Trill."

Acting and Edd became inseparable. From these humble beginnings he applied himself with vigor, and, as a result, he was soon tapped by Hollywood.

On Many TV Shows
Since his arrival in California, Edd has appeared on many television shows including "Lux Video Theatre," "Matinee Theatre," "Crossroads," "Jim Bowie," "Wire Service," and "Navy Log." He had leading roles in "Oh Susanna" and "Cheyenne." In addition to "Fear Strikes Out" for Paramount, in which he plays a friend of Tony Perkins, he also appeared in the Ring Theatre production of "Tea and Sympathy," and in the motion pictures "Girls Reform School" and "Johnny Trouble," being featured in the latter.

Despite the fact that he makes a point to indicate that he is fully aware of the suddenness of his recent successes, he is quick to point out that he refuses to qualify his secured future when he says, "I realize that eight years is nothing compared to the intensive apprenticeship served by great stars of the American stage, but I do think it's unfair to discount it entirely."

The third foundation will not only help assure his continued success but firmly establish him not only as a model for the teenager but a favorite of the older generations. This is his awareness of the great influence for good he can be and his determination to accomplish this end.

The word "jivetalk" has a very bad connotation for most of the older generations. Throughout the ages, most parents have frowned upon the peculiarities of the younger generation. This drive of the

teenager to express himself has resulted in the current "jive talk" craze.

However, there is one notable difference at this time. The crime rate among teenagers is higher than ever before. We need only walk down the street of even the finest neighborhoods to witness the obvious lack of respect, discourtesy and ill-bred manners of many of the present day teenagers.

Native of New York
As a native New Yorker, where the crime rate among teenagers is the highest in the country, "Kookie" is well aware of this situation. "Each generation," he says, "finds something all its own. Jive talk gives teenagers of today something private and personal through which they communicate with one another outside the adult world which surrounds them. You don't have to be a delinquent to be 'on,'" adds "Kookie." "Being highly im-
