"The cards of the dummy," says Poor Alfred's Almanac, "and the rest of the game of bridge." West opens the five of hearts. East puts up the queen, and South wins with the ace. Dummy's nine will act as a second high stopper if the opponents continue the suit, so South is in no immediate danger.

Nevertheless, South is not overjoyed with his contract. He can easily win four clubs and the three side aces, but this will leave him two tricks short. If he goes after two diamonds, the opponents may take two diamonds and two hearts.

South can surely develop two extra spade tricks if he can reach dummy's ten. The trick is to reach dummy's ten.

The clubs may provide the two extra tricks if South keeps his eye open. South should cash his king and queen of clubs first to see whether or not the suit is going to break normally.

When both opponents play two rounds of clubs, South can lead before leading another club. The dummy's king is usually worth a trick more than two diamonds.

Rate Hike Unopposed. Hartford, May 4 (AP)—No opposition has appeared at public hearing here on a proposed gas rate increase filed by the Hartford Electric Light Company.

The hearing moved into its second session today before the state Public Utilities Commission. In support of the company's position, Vice President Samuel Ferguson Jr. testified that the company is paying about \$476,000 more a year for the gas it buys than it would if the rates prevailing in June 1957 had been continued. He cited several increases that have taken place since that date in net earnings before income taxes in 1958 over 1957 was due to drastic changes in weather conditions and abnormally high costs in 1959 were responsible for the increase of about \$17,000, he said.

Part of Plane Found. Madison, May 4 (AP)—Part of an airplane has been found in Long Island Sound near the spot where a light plane was believed to have crashed in 1955. Three men were lost on the foggy night of Nov. 18, 1954. Only a tail, tobacco pouch and nose wheel had been found until last week.

Charles B. Jordan, 62, Clinton, said yesterday he was dragging the Sound for bits and pieces of the plane. He said he had a small boat with him and a net. When he attempted to raise the object, only a piece of airplane metal came up. It was not certain today what the object was. The plane, a chartered craft, carried contractors Eugene Sullivan, 50, Shrewsbury, Mass., George Horton, 49, Cheshire, Conn., and pilot Albin Beltrami, 34, Providence, R. I. A hat identified as Horton's later washed up, and a tobacco pouch identified as Beltrami's was found. The nose wheel washed ashore 50 miles away on Long Island.

Real Emergency. Hartford, May 4 (AP)—Dwight State Highway Commissioner Ralph L. Hager enroute to the Civil Defense control center Tuesday afternoon discovered a cave-in along the highway in Mansfield. He radioed the CD headquarters that it was a real emergency and not to be confused with the exercises of the test alert. Emergency crews were dispatched to the scene to barricade the dangerous cave-in until permanent repairs could be made.

Sedlak Starts Race. Hartford, May 4 (AP)—Former Congressman-Large Antoni N. Sedlak today opened his campaign for reelection to the post he held for six terms before he was ousted in 1958 by Democrat Frank Kowalski of Meriden. The Rockville Republican kicked off his campaign before the Women's Republican Club of Hartford at their annual meeting in the Wampanoag Country Club West Hartford. He is considered assured of re-election at the party's state convention opening in Hartford, June 6.

He said he is seeking reelection to help return "the voice of the people of Connecticut to the House of Representatives. I also want to back up the most experienced presidential candidate in our history—my former colleague, Dick Nixon," he added. Sedlak, who this week quit his \$12,000 job with the Veterans Administration to concentrate on his post, said: "I would be much more reluctant that I am to leave a pleasant and profitable government position to seek reelection were I not so convinced that the present Democratic House delegation has failed to provide the people of our state with the kind of representation it should have."

Promoting to campaign positively on the issues, the former Congressman said the record of his opponent "will be discussed thoroughly and fairly. I have lived among them all my life. I know their problems and their needs. I am prepared to work just as hard as I did in previous terms to help them."

GOP State Chairman Edwin H. May Jr. in introducing Sedlak described him as "hard working, effective, able and experienced."

of emergency measures designed to cope with a simulated atomic attack on the country. The exercises, Operation Alert 1960, was begun yesterday and ends tomorrow. It is the seventh such nationwide drill and the first this year.

For 30 minutes yesterday all television stations in the nation were blacked out. Radio stations halted their regular programs to permit a switchover to the CON-ELRAD system for confining "enemy" bombers while transmitting emergency instructions to the public.

In most places there was no activity except by officials concerned with Civil Defense. Most participation by federal workers in Washington was at the Pentagon and the State Department. Some other departments kept the workers on their jobs during the 15 to 30 minute evacuation exercise.

In the Pentagon, more than 25,000 employees were herded into hallway shelters. Some "token" representatives were flown to Bolling Airfield in various emergency command posts in Maryland and Virginia.

At the State Department, 4,900 employees were herded into their offices and left the buildings in a matter of minutes. The evacuation was the first since last year. New York City's response to the practice air raid alert was classified excellent despite the arrest of demonstrators who defied a police order to clear the area.

For 15 minutes yesterday Manhattan had the look of a ghostly city as a hazy pall of smoke and dust hung over the city. Police refused to let anyone into the area. They had to clear the area of people and cars. Police arrested about 10 other persons in scattered incidents.

In busy Times Square, some 5,000 strollers fled out of sight in under two minutes. At the New York Stock Exchange, 2,000 brokers fled to the basement while business halted in the midst of a strong stock rally.

More than 156,000 homes were completely destroyed in the immediate blast zone (up five miles from ground zero). About 260,000 additional homes were either severely damaged, or required major repair or suffered light damage in a range extending 15 miles and more from the bomb strike point.

The figures, released today by Schatzman, do not include those that would be affected by radiological fallout.

The bomb which struck West Hartford was a 4-megaton yield and caused 178,925 deaths and completely destroyed 80,500 homes in the 5-mile range.

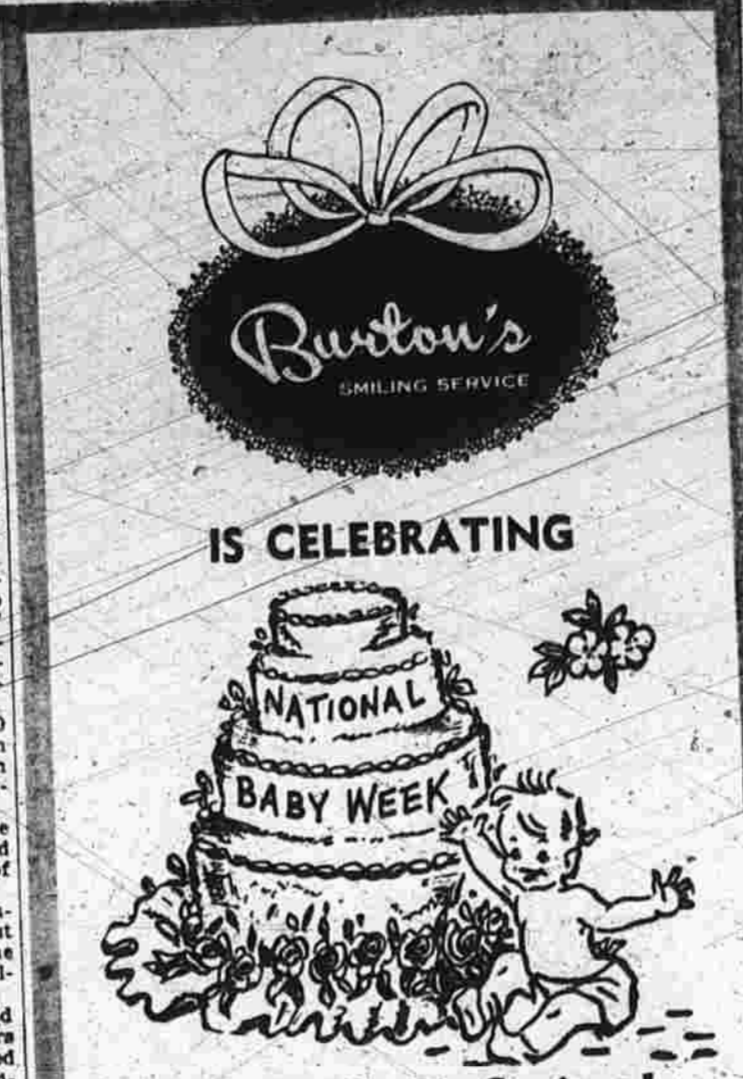
Up to 10 miles it severely damaged 61,150 homes and in the 10 to 15 mile zone caused damage requiring minor repairs to 44,500 homes. Beyond this an additional 14,625 homes suffered light damage.

A large bomb over Westover Field, caused light damage to 12,875 homes in eastern Connecticut, and killed about 200 persons. The same bomb spread radiological fallout from Westover Field to New London. CD workers have been unable to enter areas covered by the fallout. The State Control Center at Storrs theoretically had to be relocated because of its shielding from radiological fallout.
