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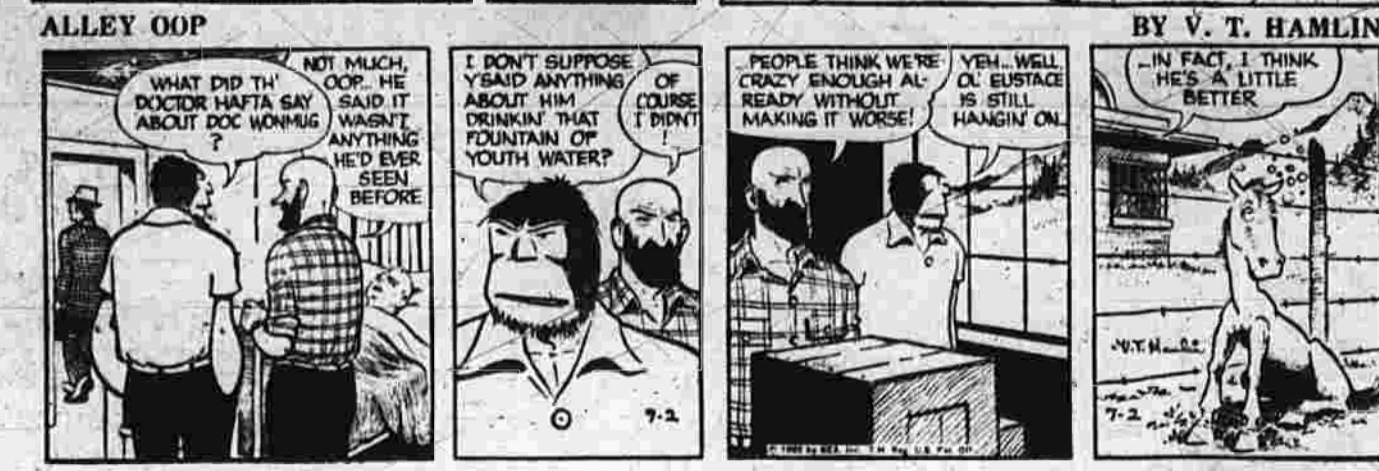
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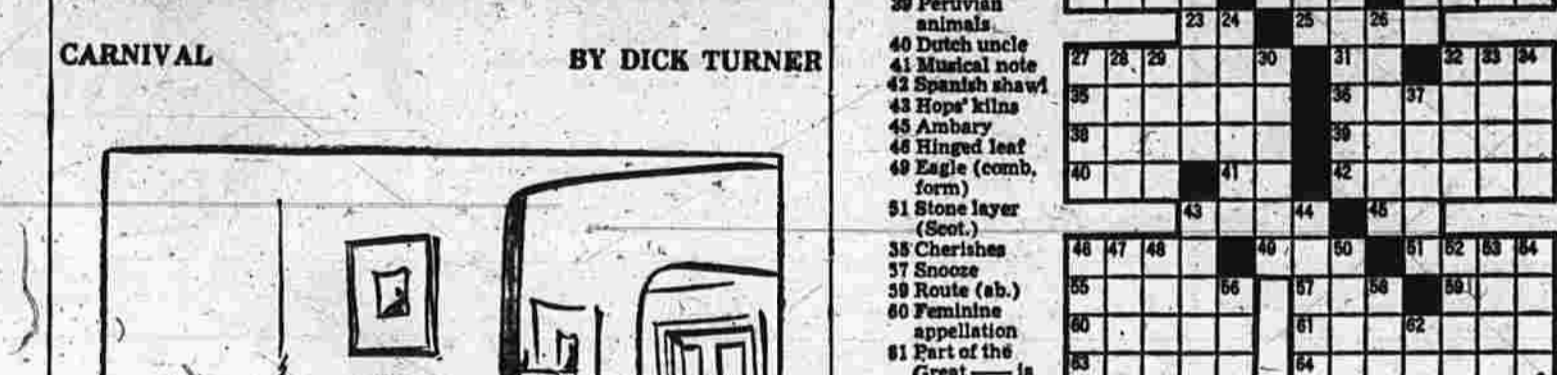

Emcee Jack Bailey

'Queen for a Day' On Air 15 Years

By CHARLES J. LEAVY "Would you like to be Queen For A Day?"

When master of ceremonies, Jack Bailey, pops that question Monday through Friday over the NBC-TV Network, millions of housewives from Maine to California bring their daily chores to a halt to watch and listen to that undisputed king of the nation's daytime audience participation programs.

From an unpretentious beginning in 1945 at Newk York's Long-acre Theatre to the giant of all give-away shows (\$17,000,000 to date), "Queen For A Day" has consistently won awards, high ratings and the support of radio and television audiences for more than 15 dazzling years.

Today, "Queen For A Day" plays host to 300 women daily at a famous Hollywood theatre-restaurant, the Moulin Rouge.

Each day's Queen not only gets her wish granted but also receives a bevy of gifts valued at approximately \$3,500. In addition, she usually gets an all-expense paid trip to some vacation spot ranging in cost from \$500 to \$5,000.

When I asked Jack how he accounts for the long-standing suc-

cess of "Queen For A Day," he cheerfully replied, "Honesty and simplicity. Long before payola and rigged TV shows were ever heard of, we conducted an investigation of our own show to assure the maintenance throughout every facet of the production of an honest and straightforward show. It was so successful that NBC has since based its investigations on ours."

Single Advice

An indication of Jack's approach to his job can be found in the single bit of advice he gives almost daily to nervous contestants. "Be yourself," he says cheerfully, "And they'll love you. Honesty and sincerity are two things an audience can sense. You can't fool them for a minute."

"We never look for misery stories," Jack said in an unusual serious manner (for him) in answer to our question that many critics have called the show maudlin and over-sensitive. "We choose people who have had some bad breaks or are down on their luck and give them a chance to attain to some degree their wishes.

"In all these years, I can truthfully say we have never been embarrassed or found ourselves ill at ease because of an overemotional candidate. Before the show, the candidates are selected carefully for entertainment value, and the possibility of embarrassing emotional troubles developing are avoided."

Bailey's rare ability to combine professionalism with genuine charm and sincerity, plus his personal concern over each candidate, has won him recognition as a top master of ceremonies and has made him a Prince Charming to millions of women from Maine to California.

As master of ceremonies for "queen," Jack has interviewed more women, given away more prizes, and brought more genuine happiness to American families than any other emcee in the history of radio and television.

Bailey readily admits what few men will. "Women have made me what I am today, and I'm glad. To me, every lady is a Queen. That's exactly the way I treat them."

Kids Self

He prefers to kid himself rather than the usually nervous candidate appearing before him, weighted down with problems.

"I turn a gag on myself when it appears to be embarrassing a participant. I never try to be 'cute' or make fun of a visitor who is in unfamiliar circumstances and on foreign ground.

"It's better to temper wit with mercy and feeling — no matter how tempting a situation may be."

"I want candidates for "Queen For A Day" to feel at home, to enjoy themselves as I hope studio audience and listeners do. Because these folks are my show. Without them there wouldn't be a program. They compliment me by coming."

Jack has been eminently prepared for his most successful occupation. Throughout his career, he has run the gamut piano playing and running his own amateur theater at the age of ten to a 5-instrument musical jack-of-all-trades to acting in Summer Stock, insurance salesman, instructor at a dance school, gas heater cleaner, silverer, home painter and carnival barker.

Jack's introduction to radio came in 1938 on a show called "Nutt News" on a San Diego station. As a result of his air antics, he was brought to Hollywood to run the "Rise And Shine" program. His success won him two network shows, "Potluck Party" and "Meet the Missus," which he

wrote and emceed for two years. In the same era, he announced for "Ozzie and Harriet" and "Duffy's Tavern," and emceed "Stop the Villain," "Country Fair," "Darts for Dough," "Women Are Wonderful," "Glamour Manor," and "Money On The Line."

"Queen For A Day," on which Jack originally was hired in 1945 as a 2-week replacement, has now become his major achievement.

Cooks, Paints

Jack's hobbies are cooking and painting. This hobby of liking to "mess around the galley" led to his own book, "What's Cooking." He owns an enviable 150 volume uclinary library that is a gourmet's delight.

His favorite dish? In his own words, "I'm not a steak happy male. I think casseroles come first — one of my favorites is a noodleburger, page 52," he pointed out with a smile.
