Bowles said he could not run for reelection in good conscience because of the opposition in the United States. He would ask me to serve in any one of several ways, but I would not feel qualified to do so. As a newly elected member of Congress, I would be expected to serve out my term, this would be impossible.

He said his "regretful decision" to withdraw from the congressional race was one of the most difficult of his life.

Bowles' successor in the race will be chosen later by the 16 members of the Connecticut State Central Committee from the 16 congressional districts.

Pension Plan Assets Stand At \$653,886

The Manchester pension plan had \$653,886 in assets as of last June 30, according to an annual report from James Arthur, chairman of the Town Pension Board.

Over the 1959-60 fiscal year, which ended June 30, \$41,553 was paid out in pensions, Arthur said. There are 46 pensioners.

Over the same period, the 245 active members of the plan contributed \$27,695, the town government kicked in \$50,000, and interest earned from investments amounted to \$17,200 he said.

Plan members pay 2 1/2 per cent of their salaries and the town appropriates yearly amounts. The investments are in U.S. treasury securities and U.S. Savings bonds.

Arthur also noted that the Hartford National Bank was hired as investment advisor last winter and Town Directors voted to make pension plan membership compulsory for all town employees hired after March 1959. The bank will act as advisor in a more liberal investment program the Directors also approved last year.

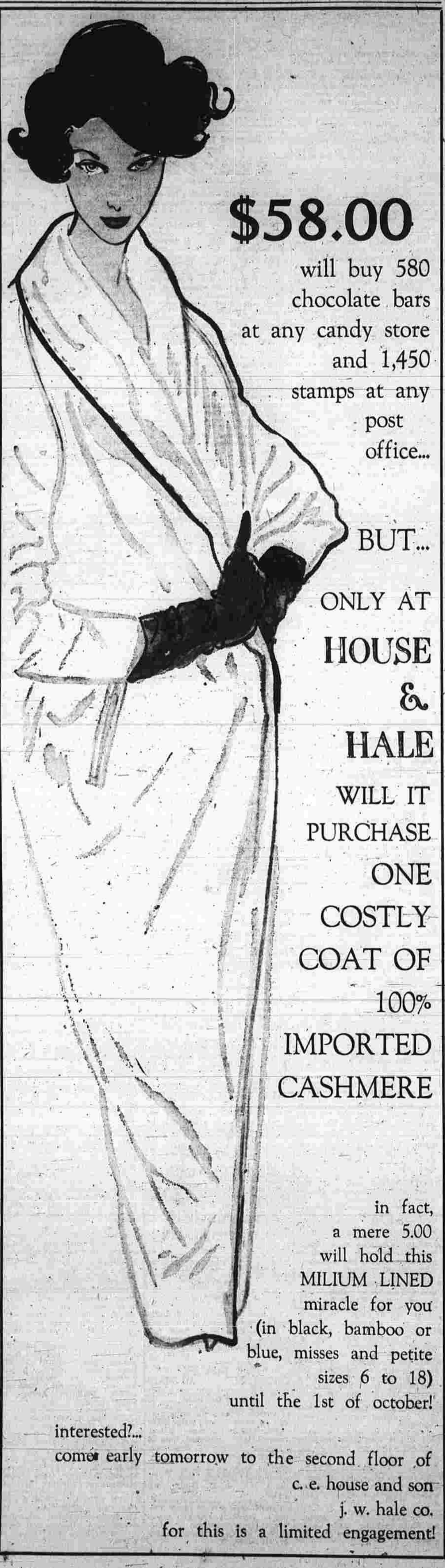
