major man-in-space project that

The problem of re-entry will altion concerning Project Appolo, a major man-in-space project that might become operational by 1966. And with this may come the break-through in manned flight being sought by our Congressional leaders. This project is being geared to overlap Project Mercury which is scheduled to run through 1962.

The objective of the new project is to support at least three men in space for periods ranging from two weeks to two months as a space station circling the earth or

two weeks to two months as a space station circling the earth or for shorter periods on a circumlunar mission.
