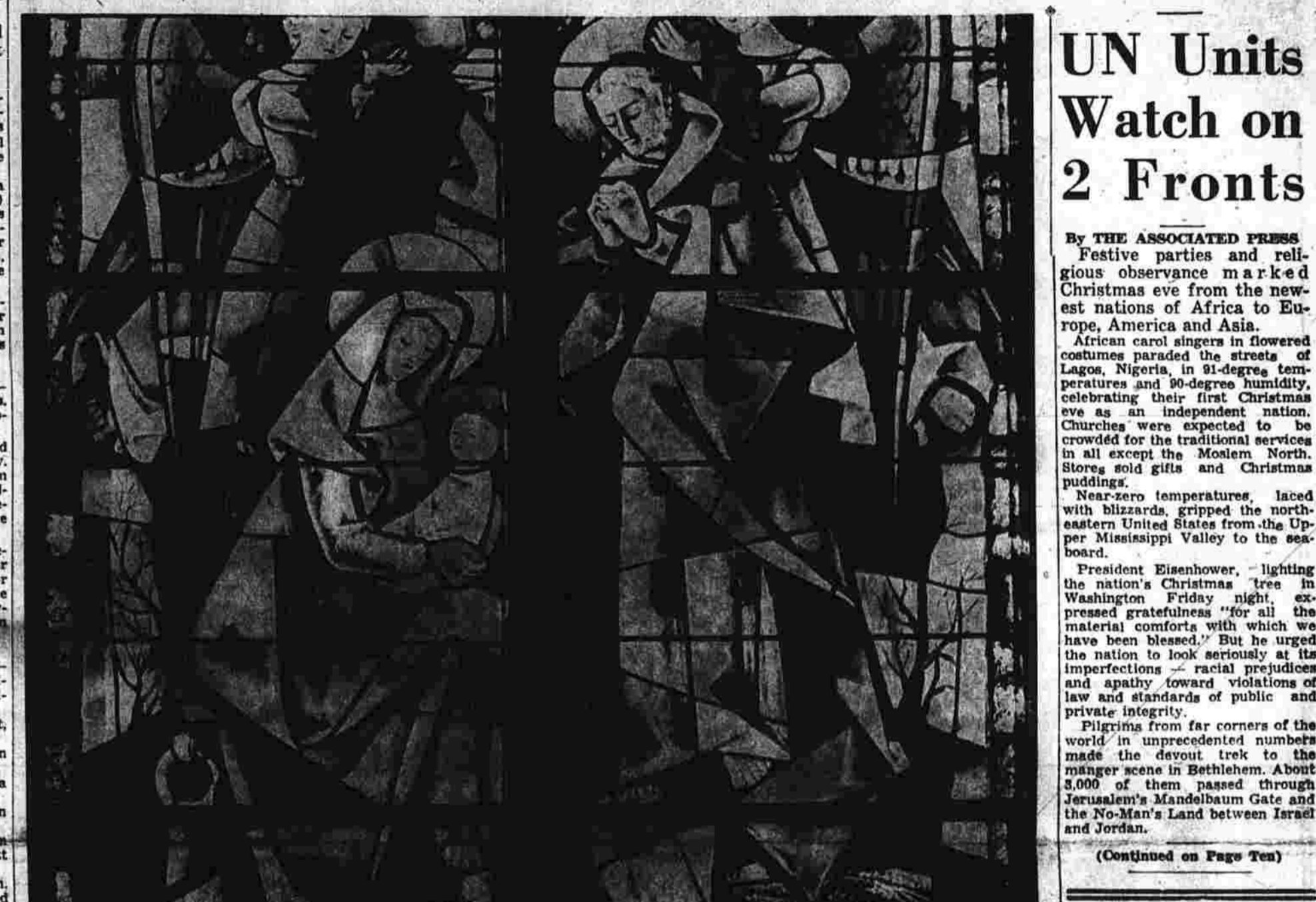

UN Units Watch on 2 Fronts

Festive parties and religious observance marked Christmas eve from the newest nations of Africa to Europe, America and Asia.

African carol singers in flowered costumes paraded the streets of Lagos, Nigeria, in 91-degree temperatures. Churches were expected to be crowded for the traditional services in all except the Modern North. Stores sold gifts and Christmas puddings.

Near-zero temperatures, laced with blizzards, gripped the north-eastern United States from the Upper Mississippi Valley to the sea-board.

President Eisenhower, lighting the nation's Christmas tree in Washington Friday night, expressed gratitude "for all the material comforts with which we have been blessed." But he urged the nation to look seriously at its imperfections, racial prejudices and apathy toward violations of law and standards of public and private integrity.

Pilgrims from far corners of the world in unprecendented numbers made the devout trek to the manger scene in Bethlehem. About 3,000 of them passed through Jerusalem's Mandelbaum Gate and the No-Man's Land between Israel and Jordan.

Thousands of Pilgrims Converge on Bethlehem

Bethlehem, Dec. 24 (AP)—Pilgrims from all over the world converged today in this hallowed hillside town to celebrate Christmas where Christ was born in an inn where a great number of visitors streaming into bustling Bethlehem—tourists, soldiers, shepherds, diplomats, priests, politicians and possibly a few wise men.

All came to witness the joy and pomp which mark the retelling here of the story of the Nativity. Travelers filled all the hotels in nearby Jerusalem and spread out into Ramallah and Jericho. They overflowed into convents, monasteries and private homes.

The influx was quickened by the arrival of 2,000 Christian Arabs who crossed the forbidden border from Israel yesterday. Each year Israel and Jordan—though technically still at war—agree to let Israeli Arabs through Jerusalem's Mandelbaum Gate to visit relatives and to worship at the holy places.

Other pilgrims came from distant places, from America to Afghanistan.

Bethlehem's friendly mayor, Ayoub Musallam, said he expected more than 10,000 here by tonight. "It should be different and even better than before," he said. "First of all we have more visitors. Second, they will be well contained and quietest."

Bethlehem itself looked not at all like the Christmas card scene of peaceful northern snow. Built on a hillyside, 12 miles from Jerusalem, it was pruned for the celebration.

In Manager Square in front of the massive Church of the Nativity, a banner proclaimed "Merry Christmas to all."

The next year he mailed Wilson the same card.

Constant Use and Cleaning Mellows Beauty of Silver

KAY SEERWOOD

At our house, we treasure the family silver not only for its beauty but because it is a household possession that survives from one generation to the next, carrying with it a heritage of family history.

This fact was brought home to me recently when I combed the attic in polishing the silver for a holiday party by telling them stories about the pieces. Our stock of silver and stories is limited but the youngsters were absorbed.

Many old pieces are silverplated. Homemakers are inclined to worry that continual use may "wear out" the silver and destroy the value of the piece. I put this question to Tom Wright, whose family has been concerned with the care of fine silver for 90 years.

He explained that it's not cleaning or staining that makes silver plate wear thin. "How well silver plate wears depends on its original plating weight rather than its continued use or cleaning," he said.

Flating weights vary widely. Badly worn silver plate can be replated. It's a little of the copper shows through this only adds to the antique patina.

The new silicone finishes that are intended to give silver a bright "like new" permanent finish don't excite much enthusiasm in Wright.

"The precious metal patina gives silver its heritage look," he says.

Silver over the years becomes oxidized many times and this continued action of the elements on the metal gives it a certain softness of color that we call patina, he explains. Constant use and handling, cleaning and polishing mellows the piece and give it the character we admire.

When it's not convenient or practical to use a silver piece frequently (a big platter, for example) protect it from tarnish during storage. If you store it out of sight, tarnish-resistant cloths and

Train Hits Bus, 12 Injured

St. Johns, N.J., Dec. 24 (AP)—Canadian National Railways train rammed a suburban bus filled with Christmas shoppers at a crossing here today and officials said it was a miracle nobody was killed. They reported 12 persons, including the bus driver, were injured.

The bus was entering St. Johns from Patuxent Harbor about 30 miles from the city, and slid onto the tracks of the train, a mixed passenger and freight.

Rescuers worked 20 minutes to free a woman and a man trapped in the wreckage.

The bus, demolished in the front, was dragged 90 feet by the train and stopped only when it struck a telephone pole. There is a slight downgrade at the intersection where the bus apparently skidded.

The train was leaving St. Johns for a branch-line run to Carbonara and points around Conception Bay. A snowfall that created the slippery highway conditions was the first in two weeks.

Busiest Train Stops to Honor Lonely Worker

Washington, Dec. 24 (AP)—The New Haven Railroad has asked the Interstate Commerce Commission for a new loan of \$4.6 million.

The railroad cited a continuing slump in its freight business in filing the application yesterday.

The commission recently guaranteed an earlier \$4.5 million loan, along \$1.5 million from the railroad's request.

After the ICC announced the guarantee, the New Haven filed for the additional \$1.5 million it had been denied.

Yesterday's application, however, amounts to the \$1.5 million request to \$4.5 million.

The railroad said that carloadings have continued about 7 to 10 per cent below last year's rate for the final three months of 1960. This has resulted in a reduction in revenues of approximately \$500,000 a month, the railroad said.

The New Haven also said the storm of Dec. 11 and 12 cost the line \$1 million in special expenses for maintenance and repairs and revenue losses.

The loss from Hurricane Donna in September, was put at \$240,000 and from strikes involving the Pennsylvania and Long Island railroads at \$780,000.

Her Gardens 'Sprout' in India Ink

Cleveland (NRA)—... And how does your garden grow?" Certainly not out of a drawing board if you're an average householder. Then, too, you undoubtedly do not use T-square and triangle to fill your shrubs and flowers as does Mrs. Paul Ferster, housewife and part-time landscape designer.

Mrs. Ferster combines her drawing skill with an extensive knowledge of plant life to beautify the outdoor surroundings of her friends and neighbors in suburban Littleton, Colo.

From avocation to full-scale business in three years is the accomplishment of this husband-wife team. Ferster was a hard-core salesman but pressure from friends seeking help with exterior arrangements decided this couple to create landscapes full tilt.

The Ferster workshop is a basement room in their home where Mrs. Ferster makes preliminary sketches while her husband drafts the final "drawings" to scale.

In planning landscapes Mrs. Ferster says she sees the outdoors as a co-ordinated room in which the floor, walls and ceiling—grass, hedges and trees—must be set up first. Then come the "wallpapering" or planting of flowers.

This idea is carried out at their own home, a year-round view from their dining-room window was created by filling in a hill building a retaining wall and planting evergreens.

Designing gardens that grow with children intrigues Mrs. Ferster most. Her objective is to plan back yards which grow wester as the children do.

"When children are small, one area may be planted in hardy grass for a play area. As the children grow and require less play area, it can be transformed gradually into a formal rose garden," Mrs. Ferster suggests.

To save on maintenance time and costs she has devised a unique strip of stone on the edge of beds to eliminate trimming grass by hand. Other savings are achieved by using shrubs instead of large beds of flowers and planting myrtle and ivy which are more weed-resistant than grass.

Caring for her family—son, daughter, and husband—comes first. Her other "love" are flower arranging and reading—poetry and essays.

These interests have continued since her graduation from Western Reserve University with an English major and fine arts as a minor. Little did she realize in her student days that shrubs and "sprouts" from her drawing board.

Wonders of the Universe Power for Space May Be Abundant

By Dr. V. N. LEVITSKY, Director of the Princeton Institute for Space Studies

A new and powerful tool for scientists in their quest for power to operate instruments in space may result from experiments just completed in the flight of the Atlas-Force 5,000-mile voyage of Cape Canaveral.
Inside the 12-foot vehicle were two space power experiments installed by the Missile and Space Vehicle Department of the General Electric Company. One of the experiments involved a magnetohydrodynamic generator which operates on the principle that when a super-heated gas or plasma passes through a magnetic field, electrical energy is produced. The other and more important experiment involved the familiar fuel cell. Engineers believe this fuel cell is destined to provide continuous power for space experiments.

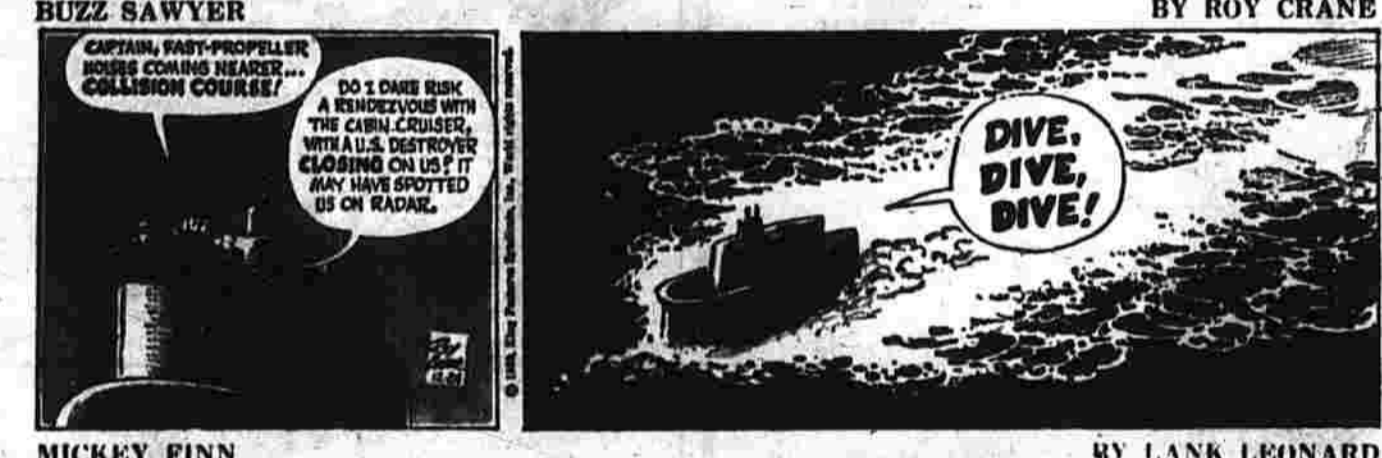

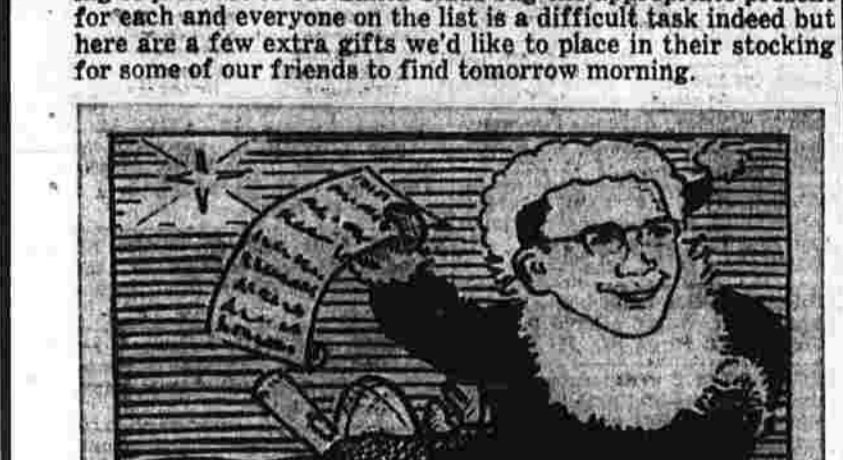

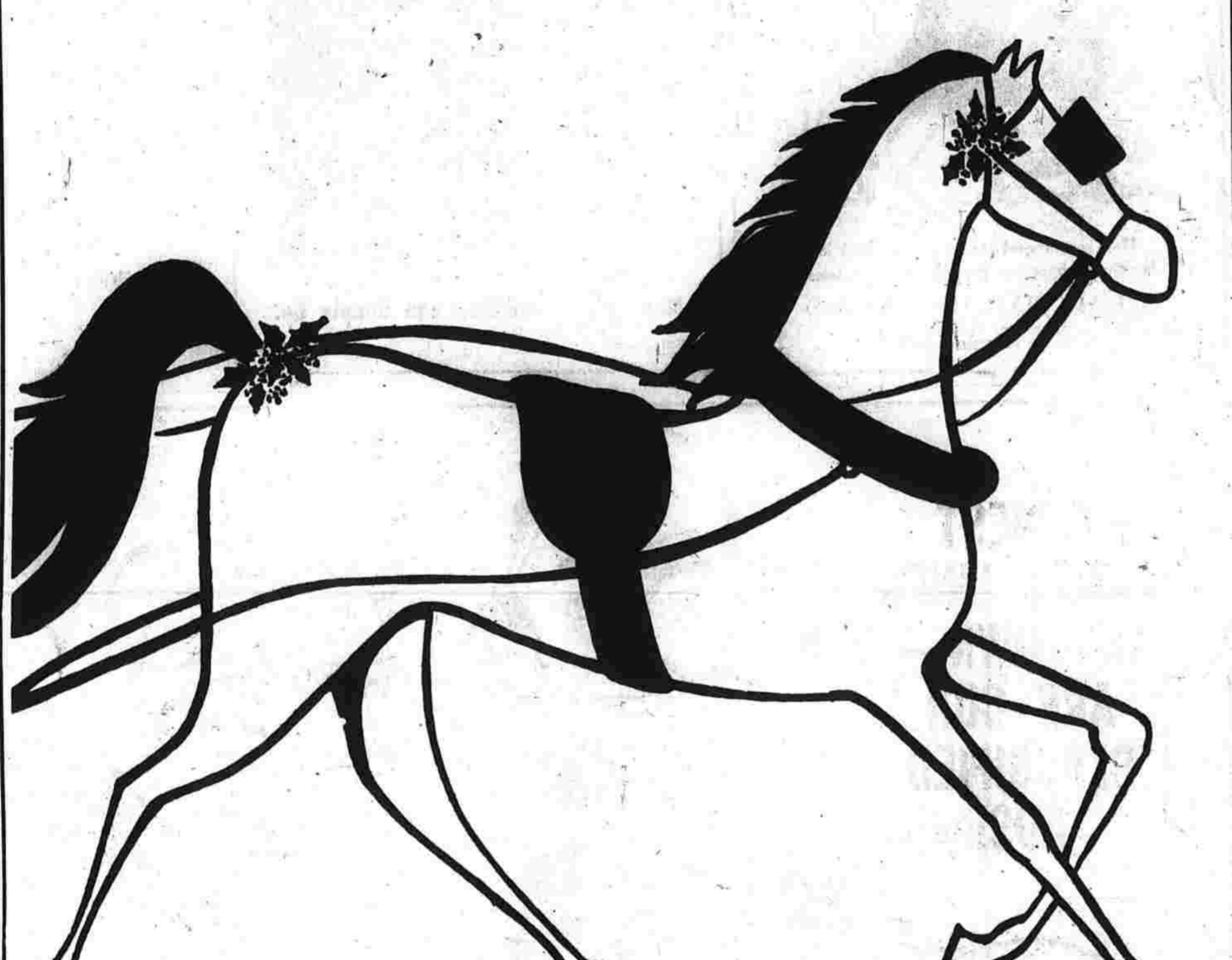
