Michael John Beale of London flew out of Cuba, just 48 hours before the recent U.S.-led invasion of the island. He was the guest of Nathan B. Getchall of New Britain.

Beale spent 12 days in Cuba just prior to the invasion. He has since returned to London and is presently under surveillance by the nervous Cubans who arrested him several times, interrogated him for about six of the twelve days he was there.

"You in the United States have underestimated Cuba," Beale said recently, adding "there must be a better way for you to handle this problem."

Beale is a student in sociology at the University of London. He is in this country on a six-month, 40,000 mile high-velocity tour of the Americas. 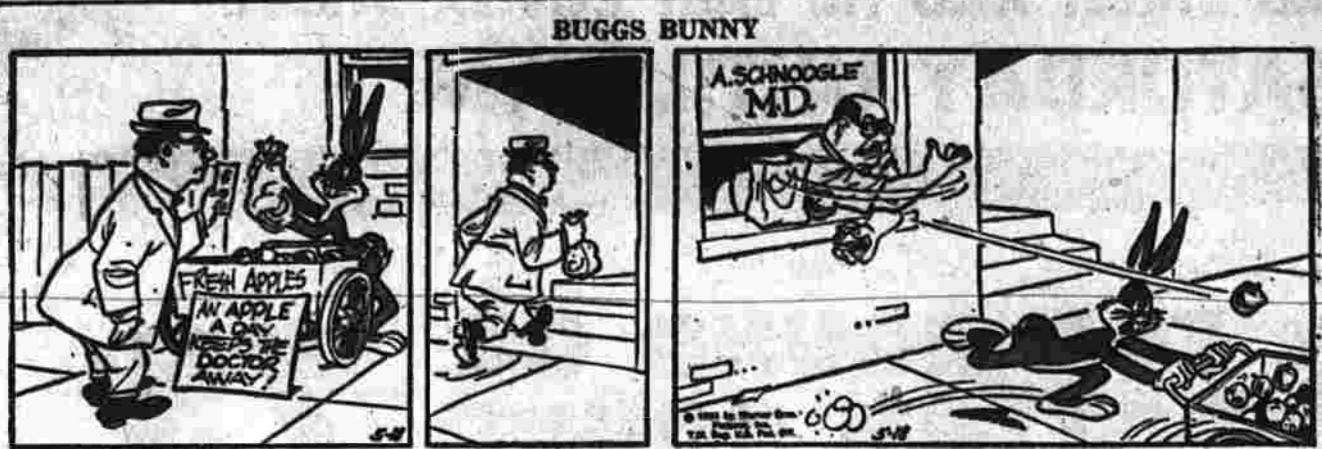

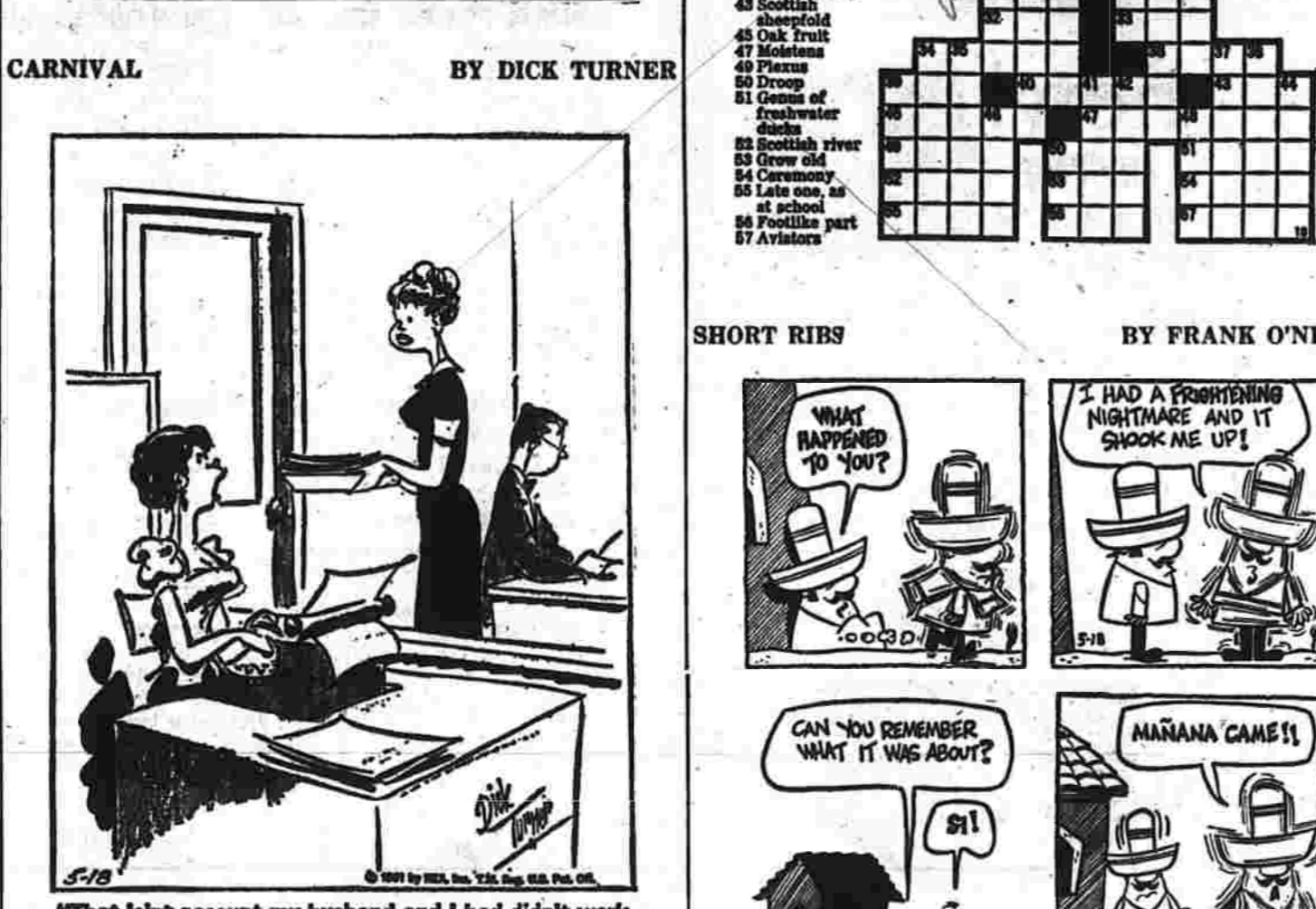
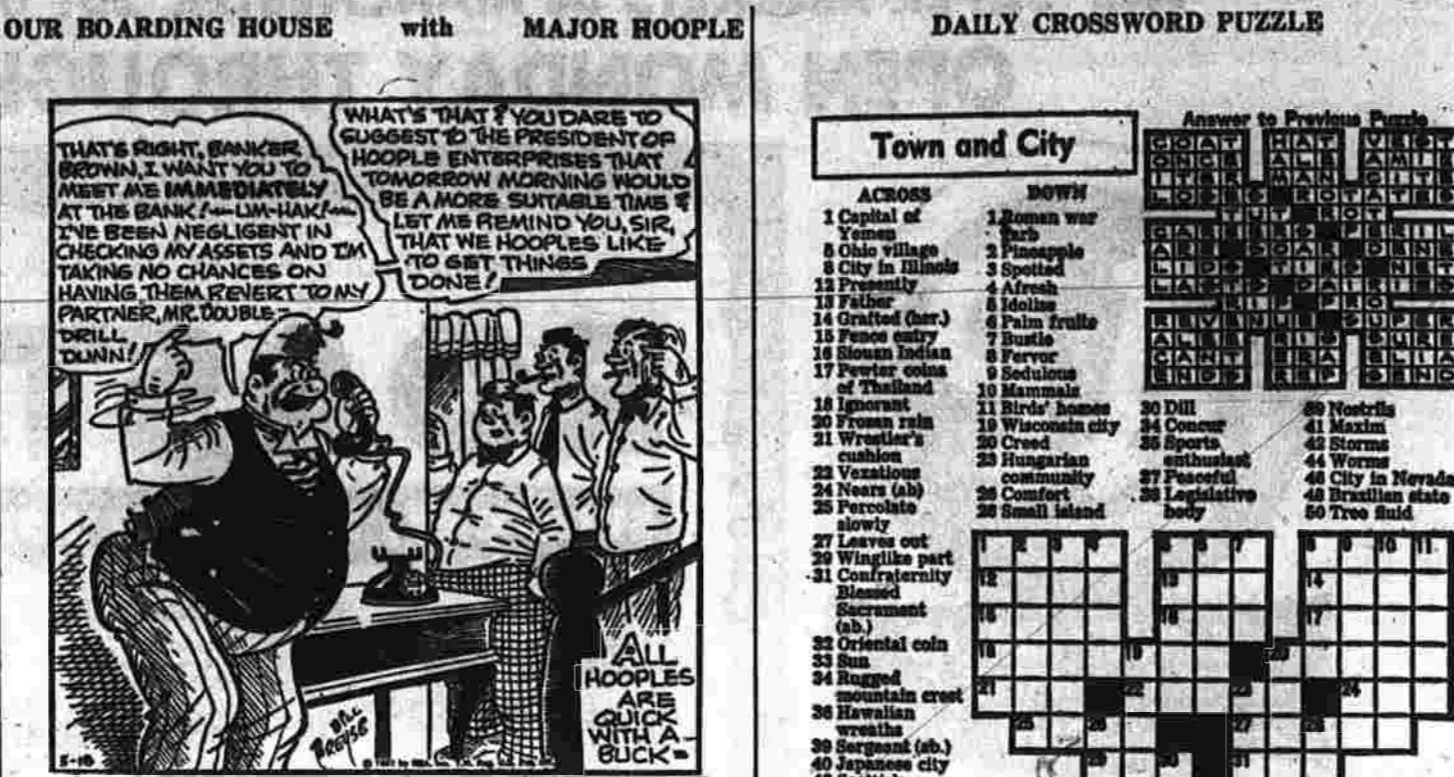
