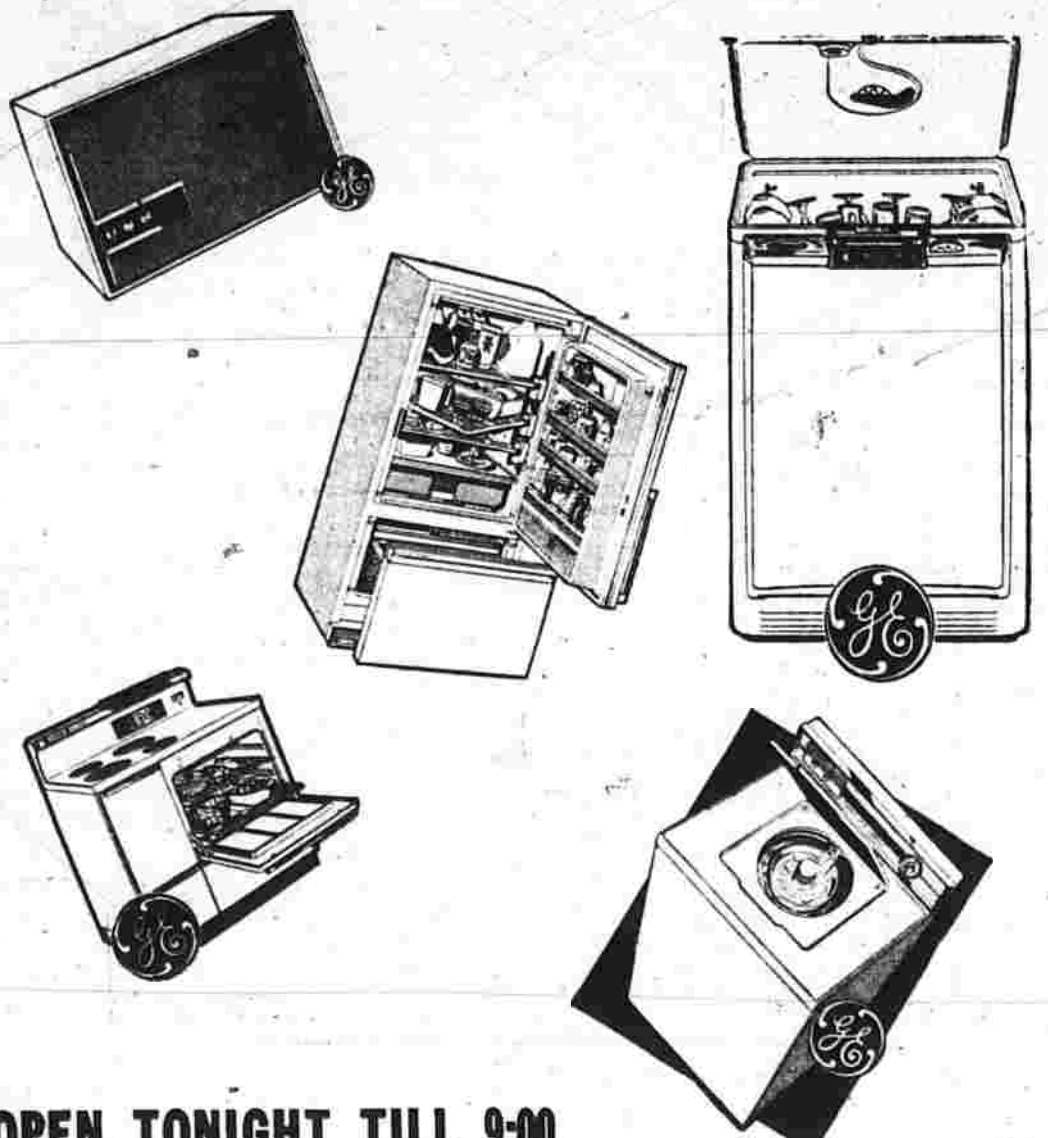

Rockville-Vernon Culvert for Hockanum Might Cost \$151,000

The cost of piping the Hockanum River for 925 feet under Rockville's urban renewal tract has been estimated at \$151,000.

The Rockville Redevelopment Agency's consulting engineer submitted the estimate yesterday in a report on the feasibility of the plan.

It will be submitted to the State Water Resources Commission as the basis for obtaining a permit to redesign the stream bed and enclose it in a reinforced concrete culvert.
