Langtry Says \$75,000 Cost To Fix Swamp

Existing facilities are inadequate, but storm drainage and land fill needed to correct conditions on a swamp land at Woodland, Broad and Hilliard Sts., would require an expenditure of \$75,000, Chester P. Langtry, deputy director of public works, reported today.

In a memo to General Manager Richard Martin concerning a petition from property owners in that area to install pipe and fill swamp land, the public works deputy reviewed the long history of the problem.



The hard rain of July 31, the area of approximately 2,000,000 feet contained at least two feet of water in some portions, Langtry reported today.

This is a problem that has been with the town for a long time. A plan prepared by J. F. Bowers, former town engineer, in 1942 was turned down and an alternate plan was carried out which has several shortcomings in the report stated. The alternate was installation of 12-inch vitrified pipe to added.

The unfortunate part of this whole procedure is the fact that it is simply not possible for a 12-inch pipe to displace 10 feet of water in the drainage area that this installation is supposed to have served, Langtry asserted.

Langtry said the public works department is aware that a storm drainage system is needed, starting at the portion of the street that is constructed and extending some 3,000 feet to the Eighth School and Utilities District property.

"I would be of benefit to bring some fill into the swamp land so it could be graded to the catch basin that would be installed in the pipe line. It would estimate that we are talking about an expenditure of close to \$75,000 to carry out this operation."

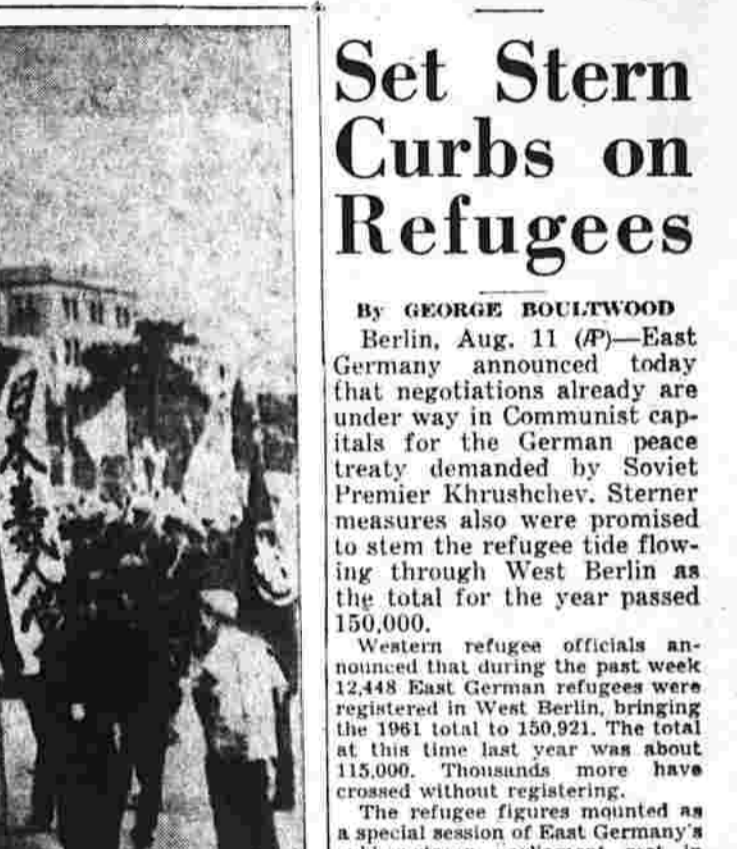
